1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a simple, wood framed one room prairie school on a concrete block foundation. The roof of the main body and the addition of the school are covered with wood shakes. There is metal capping sealing the peak. The eaves have closed soffits. The building measures 32 1/2 feet north to south and 22 feet east to west. There is a red brick chimney at the north end of the peak.

A wide header runs just under the eaves at both peaks. Siding is 6 inch lap with 4 inch corner trim. There is pretty good paint on this school. The three two pane double hung windows on both the east and west sides of the school. Two more two pane windows are on the south wall, either side of the door. Glass in all windows is intact. A 5 panel wood door gives entry into a coat room. The door was locked but I could look in windows. There is wainscot in the entry and the school room. Walls are lathe and plaster. The ceiling is pressed tin tiles and some are beginning to fall in. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood. There is an oil burner toward the north end of the school room. Blackboards are on the north wall and the east 1/2 of the south wall of the main body of the school. The door from the entry is off set to the west. There are lights hanging inside the school, a light fixture high over the entry door and wires on the south wall giving evidence of electricity.






