1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a large, one room prairie school. The hip roof roof has remnants of asphalt shingles on wood sheathing. The south slope has holes midway up the roof. There is a dormer on the east slope of the roof. There are pieces of metal capping along some of the seams. The chimney is gone. The eaves also show holes.

The siding is wood lap with no paint left. The north is a solid wall. The south side has a bank of 4 windows in various stages of destruction. It looks like some of the framing remains and little or now glass. There is an opening near the east end of the south wall that is covered, another window. The east wall has two covered openings, suspect they were windows as well. There is a door opening on the east wall. It looks like more windows on the north side, looking through the window openings on the south side. I did not go into the yard.
