The feature is a large, one room prairie school, moved to the current farmsite location for use as a storage building. The hip roof has remnants of asphalt shingles and wood shakes on wood sheathing. The roof has many holes. There is a dormer on the east slope of the roof. There are pieces of metal capping along some of the seams. The chimney is gone. The soffits were closed with beadboard and there are holes here as well.

The siding is wood lap and horizontal lumber with no paint left. A wide trim board runs along all four walls at both the top and bottom with a waterboard at the bottom trim board. The soffits were closed with beadboard and some of that has fallen away. The corner trim is metal capping. Both the north and south side have 4 double hung windows. It looks like some of the framing remains and little or no glass. The framing that remains looks to be aluminum and is perhaps outer windows added at a later date. There is an opening near the east end of the south wall that is covered, another window. A corresponding window on the north side is also covered. The east wall has two covered windows. There is a door opening on the east wall. The floor is tongue and groove and there are holes. The walls are covered with a mixture of lathe and plaster and wallboard. The ceiling was lathe and plaster and most of the plaster is now lying on the floor. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood. There are no blackboards in the building. No wainscot and no evidence of electricity.

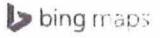

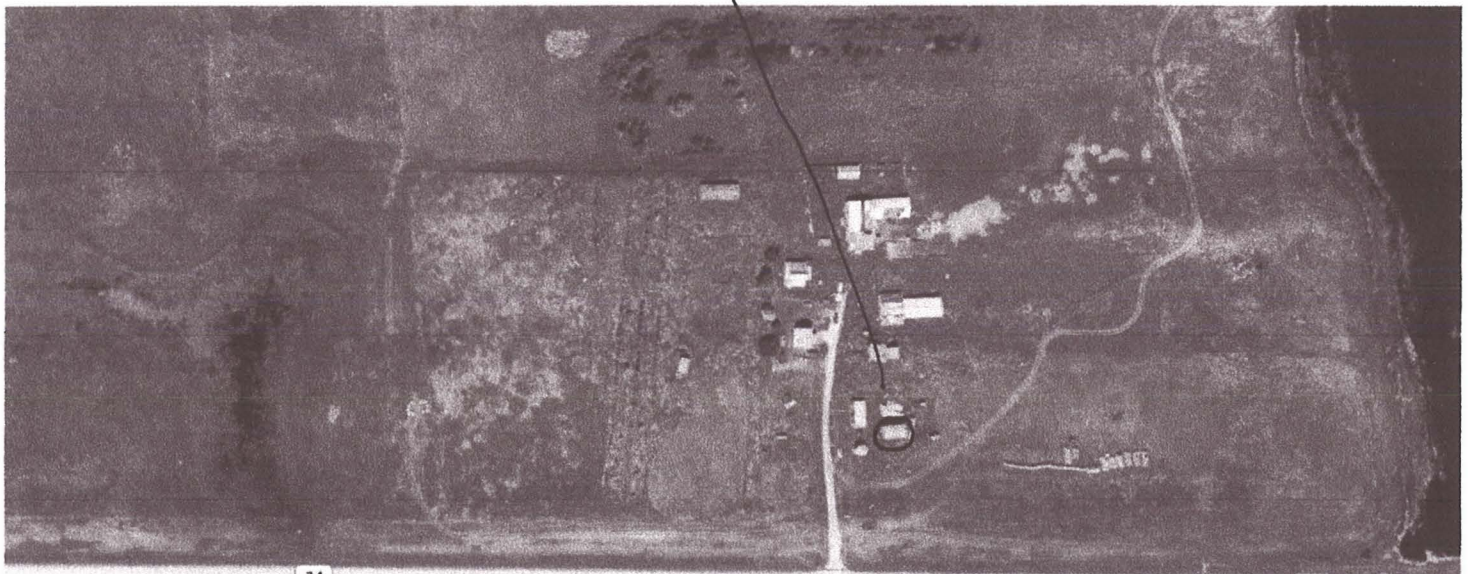

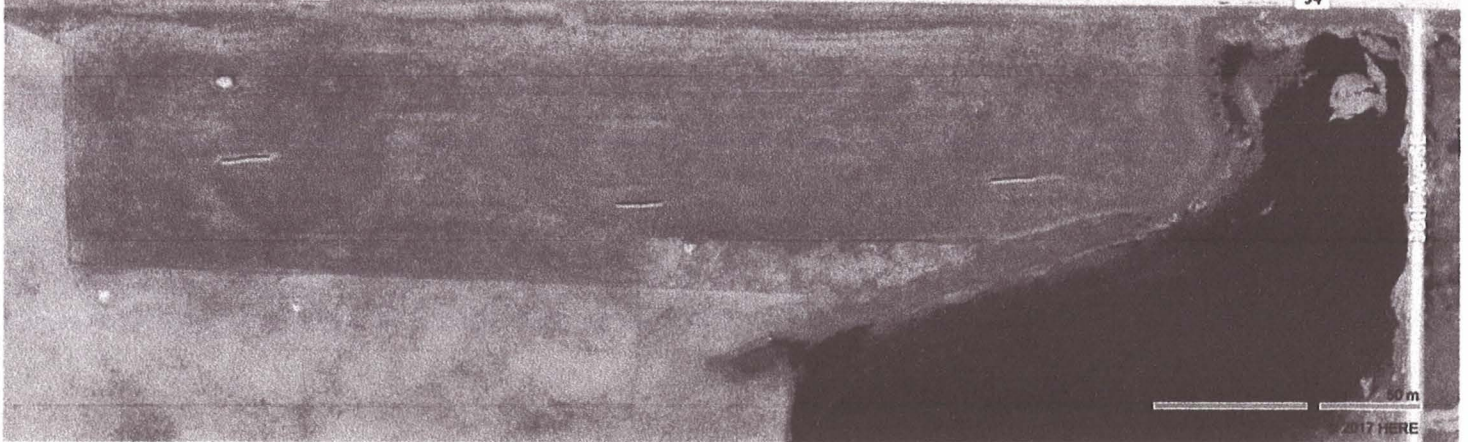


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
