School No.4 of Krem No. 4 District is a small wood-frame building under a gable roof of asphalt shingles. The metal ridgepole still has its spherical ends and the short overhanging eaves have a plain bargeboard. On the north end are two windows with a sign above that says "School District: Krem No. 4 School No. 4" in black letters. The east side has three windows covered with horizontal boards that are the same size as the two on the north end. No openings interrupt the lap siding on the west side. The south end was not visible from the right-of-way but based on other school buildings of this type, it is assumed the entrance is a single door centrally located on the wall with one or two steps up.

Associations with the local community and persons needs further investigation. In regards to Criteria A & C of National Register of Historic Places eligibility, the property may be eligible under social history or as part of a thematic nomination of country schools.

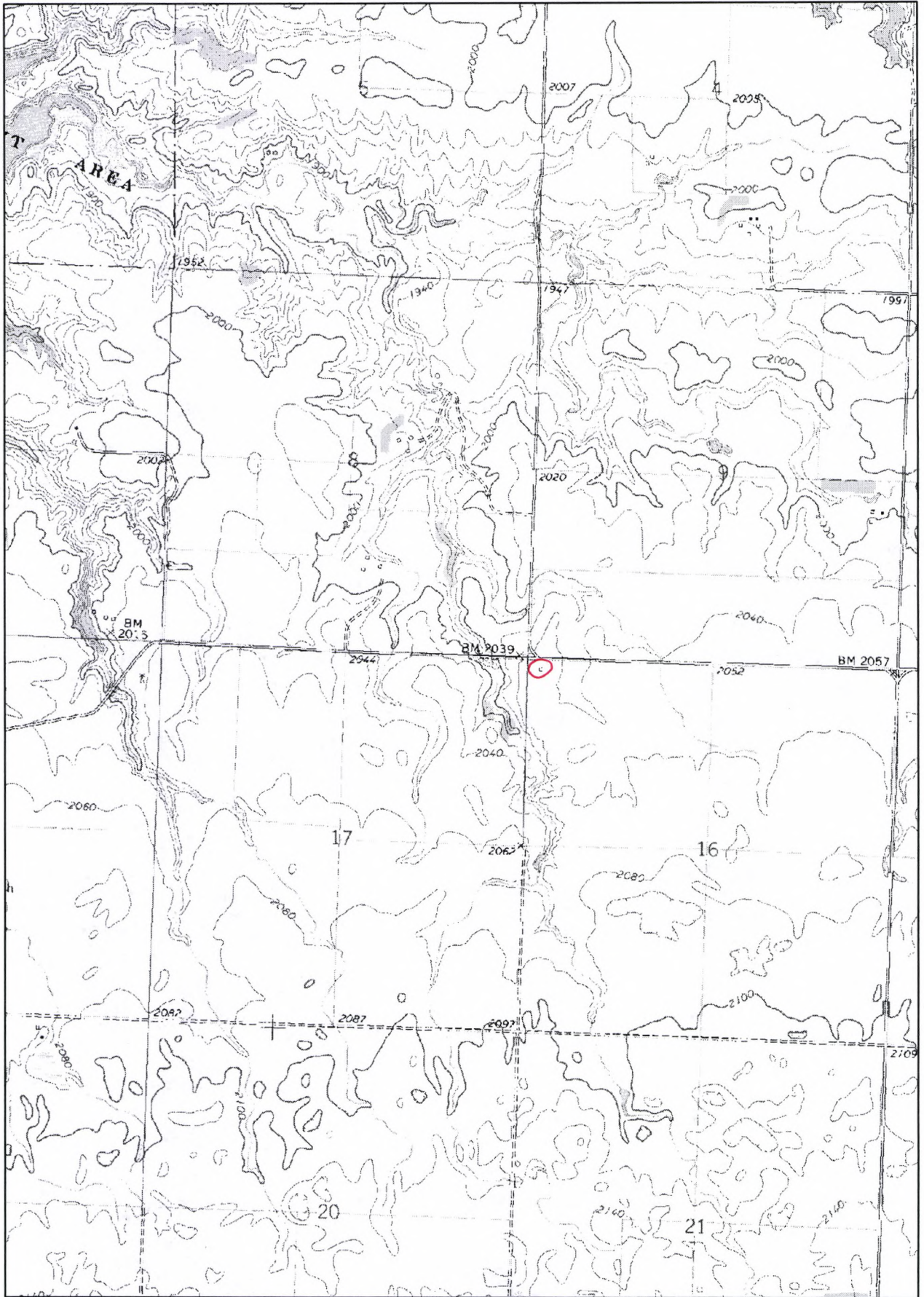
6. Summary of All Site Features & Evaluation of Site Significance:
