1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school on a foundation of concrete blocks and some poured concrete. The roof of this building is covered with asphalt shingles. There is a red and yellow brick chimney at the west end of the roof peak. The soffits are open. The building is L shaped with gables running east and west for main room and north and south for the entry. A half hip roof covers the west addition. There is a belltower on the roof of the entry without a bell. It is open on all four sides and the pyramid roof is covered with asphalt shingles as well. The school measures approximately 20 feet by 15 feet with the entry measuring 10 by 12 feet.

A rake board runs under the eaves at all the peak ends as well as under the eaves of the west addition. The remainder of the siding is 6 inch wood lap with 4 inch wood corner trim. A waterboard completes the siding. There are several windows beginning with three on the west side, two fixed pane windows in the west addition and one on the west wall of the entry. The south wall of the entry has a two over two double hung window. The north side has 8 double hung windows, configured in a set of three to either side of the middle two windows. All glass intact. One window is covered with plywood. The interior of the windows have decorative, wide cornices at the top and there are curtains on the bottom half of the window. The interior of the school is in great shape and well taken care of. The entry has brown colored beadboard walls with tongue and groove flooring. There is a door to a storage area at the west end of the entry and another 5 panel wood door for entry into the school. A 5 panel wood door leads into the entry. Railroad ties lead the way to the covered porch and into the entry. The addition on the west houses a toilet and the library. The walls of the main room of the school are lathe and plaster with wainscot on the lower 1/3. The ceiling is also lathe and plaster. The floor inside the school is tongue and groove hardwood. Blackboards run along the east wall as well as most of the south wall. There was electricity at some point but it is not connected today.

The school is part of the city park and is cared for by the city as well as people with an interest in historical preservation. The school is furnished with desks, teachers desk, stove, books, a map box, school memorabilia and more.
