1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

This feature is a one-room school building. It is situated in the SE corner of an intersection. I could not see what the foundation is made of as the grass and weeds were very high and I did not get close. I estimated this school building to be approximately 12 feet wide by 20 to 24 feet long. The building is covered with wood lap siding and the paint is in very poor shape. The east end of the building has two windows, they appear to be double hung. Most of the glass is missing from these windows. There are 4 windows on the south side, again double hung, and most of the glass is intact in these windows, three appear to be covered from the inside. There is one small window on the north side, looks like it might not be original. Perhaps it was installed to give some light to the entry area. The chimney is of modern looking brick. The shingles are wooden shakes and appear to be in pretty good shape with a few areas that have metal covering where the shakes fell off. The entrance to the school is on the west side and the lack of paint around the door leads me to believe there might have been a small porch on the building at some time. Also on the west end of the building is evidence of electricity. I spoke with a former student and he told me it was updated inside with new sheet rock and a lowered ceiling. The community used it for township meetings, card parties and other group meetings.
