1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

Lake Margaret School #3, also known by the locals as the Casper Slough School, was originally located in Lake Williams Township. This wood framed school building was built in the 1920's after the first school burned. The school now sits in Horseshoe Valley Township on the Roger Boyko farm. It was moved to the farm in 2002 and refurbished and furnished for an Open House in 2006. The school has wood lap siding with good paint on it. On the west side there is a boarded up opening that probably was the fuel door. The entry to the school is on the north side and there is a wood door that leads into the entry. On either side of the door there are double hung windows and there is also a transom window over the door. The roof is in good repair with asphalt shingles. On the roof above the entry door there is a small dorner with a window. There is a newer, brick chimney just south of the dormer. The east side has six windows in sets of two. The school sits on concrete footings and there are three boards of newer siding all around the bottom of the school. There is a concrete apron and steps to the entry.

Inside the entry there are coat hooks, a bench and a small desk. The lathe and plaster walls are painted a light blue and the bottom 1/3 of the wall has wainscoating painted a light green. There is a wash room with a towel hanger in the entry as well. Step through a door at the east side of the coat room into the main body of the school. It is bright with morning sun and nicely furnished with period pieces. The black boards are along the south and west walls and a piano sits on the west wall. All the window trim inside the school has been painted white while the walls are a soft yellow. Again there is wainscoating around the entire room, also painted light green. The window's have shades at midpoint, the pull up and down. The floor is 4 inche wood and the ceiling is decorated tin with cornices of the same tin. On the north wall of the school there is a built in bookcase, filled with books, and another area that looked like a second bookcase which has been made into a window opening on the top and a passthrough on the bottom. The bookcase is finsihed wood and the other has been painted to match the wainscoating. The space behind the painted bookcase is currently a store room. That space used to be in two parts, half for the coal bin and the other half was the original room. Later the coal bin became a playroom and kitchenette. The ceiling is decorative tine with cornices of the same tin material. There are two ceiling lights with typical white "school house" globes. Electricity came to the area in 1949 and the school was connected December 20 for \$5.00.

The school measures 20 feet east to west and 36 feet north to south. The last year the teacher filied a report was 1959.


