1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a well kept one room school situated in Heritage Park in the City of Garrison. The school was donated to the Park by Donald Jamtgard, former owner of the land and school in Douglas Township. The school came from 150N 82W Section 8, the southeast quarter.

This building has asphalt shingles and 6 inch lap siding with nice paint. The corners are trimmed with 6 inch board lumber and 8 inch trim boards follow the roof line. There is no longer a chimney on the roof. The entry door is to the north with a transon window above the door. The door is a 4 panel, wood door and it was locked. A poured concrete step leads to the door. There are four double hung windows on the east side and all are in good shape.

This school building measures 24 feet north to south and 16 feet 4 inches east to west.

The interior of the school has composite wall board, painted white, and off white painted wainscoting. The ceiling is bead board, also painted white. Near the entry door there are coat hook along the wall to the west. The floor is wood and I believe the south wall would have a black board although I could not see that wall. The west wall had pictures, maps and books in bookcase along its length.

The last Douglas Township schools closed in 1959.




