1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

This feature is a one room prairie school on a concrete foundation. The gable roof is covered with metal sheeting. A small addition to the west end of the school has a shed roof covered with asphalt shingles. There is a concrete block chimney located at the west end of the roof at the peak. The soffits are open. This school measures 32 feet east to west and 15 feet north to south.

The siding begins with a rake board under the peaks and is then 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch wood corners. The door on the east side of the building is 3 panel wood with a covered window at the top 1/3. This is reached by two steps to a conrete pad. There is not a separate coatroom inside the school proper. To the right as you walk in the door there is a small closet. The interior walls are covered with wallboard. More wallboard covers the sloped ceiling as well. There are three windows on the north side, glass intact and covered with plywood. Two similar windows on the south side are also covered. There is a small window in the plywood shutter of the middle window on the south side, likely put in for light. On the west end of the building there is a plywood addition with a plywood door on the north wall. No access to this shed from inside the school. The floor is tongue and groove pine. No blackboards or wainscot. Electrical box on the west wall and light fixtures indicate electricity. A small stove connected to the chimney sits at the west end of the school room. There is an outhouse directly west of the school. The building is used for storage.
