#### 1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school on a poured concrete foundation. The gable roof of the main body and the entry roof are covered with wood shakes. There is a yellow brick chimney at the peak at the west end of the roof. The soffits are closed. There is a stub of a flagpole at the east end of the peak. The building measures 26 1/2 feet east to west and 18 feet north to south with the entry measuring 10 feet north to south and 12 feet east to west.

There is a wide trim board on the exterior wall just under the soffits on the peak ends of the school. The rest of the siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch wood corner trim. There is an 5 panel wood entry door, reached from a concrete step and pad, leading into a small room with tongue and groove hard wood floor. The entry walls and ceiling have beadboard. Another 5 panel wood door leads into the main school room. The walls are covered with a mixture of beadboard and wallboard. The ceiling is covered with beadboard. There is one covered windows in the entry, all boarded up. There is one double hung window on the west wall as well as on the south wall with some glass. The north wall has 4 double hung window opening with some framing and not glass, all shuttered. The interior windows have remnants of shades from the window tops. The floor in the main body of the school is covered with tile. There are blackboards on the south wall from the window to the corner. More smaller blackboards are on either side of the east door. Light fixtures suggest electricity. The building has a stove toward the west wall. There is a mix of furniture and junk stored here.


