1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school on a poured concrete foundation. The gable roof is covered with asphalt shingles. There is a red brick chimney at the east end at the peak with a flagpole at the west peak end. The soffits are closed. The building measures 34 feet east to west and 16 feet north to south.

There is a wide trim board on the exterior wall under the soffits at the peak ends of the school. The rest of the siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch corner trim. There is a new, solid core locked door on the west side with a wood step. Three double hung, two over two, screened windows are on both the south and north sides of the school, all glass intact. The interior walls and ceiling are coverd with beadboard. There is a stage at the east end of the school room. Blackboards are on the east wall. The flooring is tongue and groove hardwood. Light fixtures suggest electricity. The school is entirely furnished as if school were still in session.




