1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school on a poured concrete with some block basement. The gable roof of the building has wood shakes and most of the shakes on the west slope are gone. The chimney is gone with a hole to show where it was. The soffits are closed. The building measures 24 feet north to south and 16 feet east to west.

The siding on the school begins with a wide trim board under the roof at the peak ends. The remainder of the siding is 6 inch wood lap with 4 inch corner trim. There is a large concrete pad with three steps leading to the entry. There is a no door remaining at the entry opening. A window next to the door has no glass and little framing. Inside the entry is a small coat room which then leads into the school room. The east wall shows boarded up window openings from the outside with wallboard covering that same wall inside. The west wall has 5 window openings with no trim and no glass. There is another door opening at the northwest corner of the school. The interior walls are a mixture of lathe and plaster and wallboard. The ceiling is lathe and plaster and much of it has fallen in. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood covered with tile. Wiring on the outside of the school would indicate electricity.






