The feature is a one room prairie school moved to the present location for use as a storage building. It was placed on a poured concrete slab. The roof is covered with metal sheeting. There is no chimney. There are decorative triangular brackets under the open soffits on the peak ends. The building measures 32 north to south and 24 east and west with an entry that measures 6 feet by 8 1/2 feet.

The siding of this building is a mixture. On the peak ends of the school, about the top 1/4 of the siding, is wood shakes. The next 1/3 of the peaked end walls is covered with 6 inch wood lap with 4 inch wood corner trim. The two long walls are 6 inch wood lap with 4 inch corner trim and the bottom 1/3 of all sides of the school have metal sheeting. A small entry at the south end of the building has similar siding to the larger peaked ends and the wood siding shows where the door opening was filled in. On the east side there is a metal sliding door to give entry to the school. The east wall originally had three sets of two windows, the middle windows were removed for the door installation. The two outer sets of windows are totally covered.

We did not go inside the school.

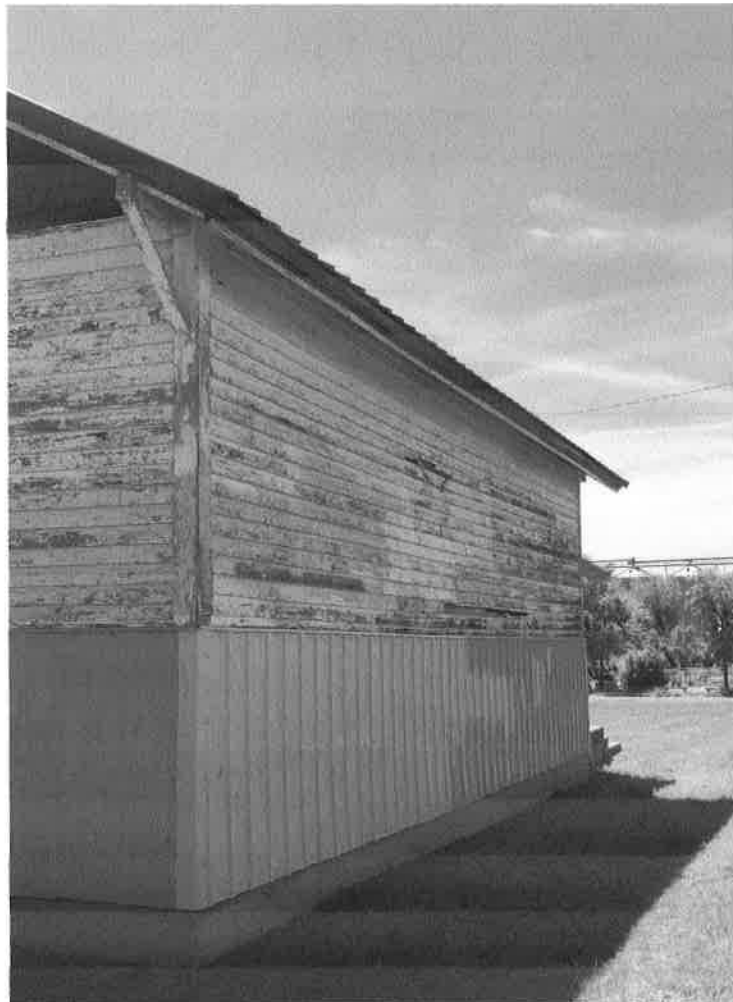
