1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school moved to this location from Section 9 of Banner Township. The building was places on a concrete slab. The roof is covered with asphalt shingles and there is not a chimney. The main part of the building measures 21 feet north to south and 32 feet east to west. There is a shed/bathroom addition at the back, west side, of the school that measures 21 feet by 6 feet. At some point yet another small shed was attached to the west most addition. The roof on this addition is beginning to fall in and the shingles are in really bad shape. This small addition measures 8 feet by 6 feet and may have been used for storage. The entry measures 10 feet by 14 feet. Gable roofs cover the school and entry and a half hip roof is found on the shed/bathroom. The soffits are open with triangular shaped brackets lending support.

A rake board runs under the peak ends of the school and entry. The siding is 6 inch wood lap with 4 inch wood corner trim leading down to the waterboard and wide trim board at the bottom. There is an entry leading into the school with a 5 panel wood door. On the south side of the entry there is one one double hung window with glass. The floor in the entry is tongue and groove hard wood. At the west wall of the entry is a tall wood railing with a door opening to the left/south that used to lead to a basement in the school's past location. Walls in the entry and school are lathe and plaster with much of it falling away. A wide trim board runs around the rooms at the base of the wall. The east wall of the school has a double garage door to give acces for a shop. Tongue and groove hard wood covers the floor in the main room of the school. There are three sets of multiply pane double hung windows on the north wall, some with some glass and most covered from the outside. Inside the school room two five panel wood doors can be seen at the west end, leading into the shed/bathroom addition. The south and east walls of the school room shows where the blackboard used to be, the chalk rail is still there. The ceiling is also lathe and plaster with much of the plaster fallen away. There is no wainscot in this school. The shed/bathroom on the west side has two 5 panel wood doors leading in to the little shed/ lean-to. There are two small fixed pane windows to either side of that lean-to, both covered. The leanto has a small opening on both the north and south sides, just under the eaves. There was no electricity, the hangers for lanterns are still haning from the ceiling.

This school was built sometime between 1916 and 1921.




