The feature is a one prairie school, moved to the present location at the Glen Ullin Museum from the Schmautz farm in Grant County, north of Heart Butte Dam. The roofing on the shed, entry and school is newer looking asphalt shingles with a concrete block chimney at the west end. The siding is 6 inch wood lap with overlapping metal ridge cap corner trim. The entire building is painted white. Under the peak of the gable roof on the school and entry there is a wide trim board. The overhand of the roof on the north and south sides is open. There is a hinged door on the south side of the shed, most likely for fuel storage. Another small, fixed pane window is on the north side of the shed. On the south side there is one double hung windows near the east end of the building and a bank of four windows on the north side. The windows are multipane double hung windows. There is a wood step with a metal hand rail to the south that leads to a 5 panel entry door. There is a light fixture at the side of the door indicating electricity. A flag pole stands on the step near the entry door. There is one window in the entry, used as a coat room. I did not go into the school but looking through windows and visiting with a person with the Glen Ullin Historical Society I learned that the walls are lather and plaster with wainscot around the room. The school is furnished in the style of the time with desks, maps and etc. Blackboards are on the south wall and another on the west. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood. I saw a light hanging from the ceiling in the school room. According the information listed about the Glen Ullin Museum the school was built in 1920.
