Gartner Farms School appears to be in the original location where it was built. The school has shakes on the roof with a metal ridge cap. Many of the shakes are missing and the board lumber under them can be seen. A few bricks of the chimney can be seen at the roof peak. The soffits on the school are all closed with a wide trim board running under the roof on all sides.

All the windows on the west side of the school are covered with wood, looking from the inside of the building I see all the glass is gone and little framing remains. Windows on the south are mostly covered but once inside the school I see that the window frames as well as some of the glass remains. There was a transom above the door which is now covered with wood. There is no porch. The entry, with door missing, leads into the school and there is a small coat room to the right, another small room to the left. Walls in the entry and main body of the school are all lathe and plaster with much of the plaster falling in. There is wainscoting in the main body of the school. The blackboards used to hang on the north wall. There is also evidence of the location of the stove on the north wall with a chimney extending from the floor to the ceiling. The ceiling is high with curved side above the windows as well as on the opposite wall. Most of the plaster in the ceiling has fallen in. Holes in the roof allow a lot of daylight and weather in. The floor is tongue and groove.

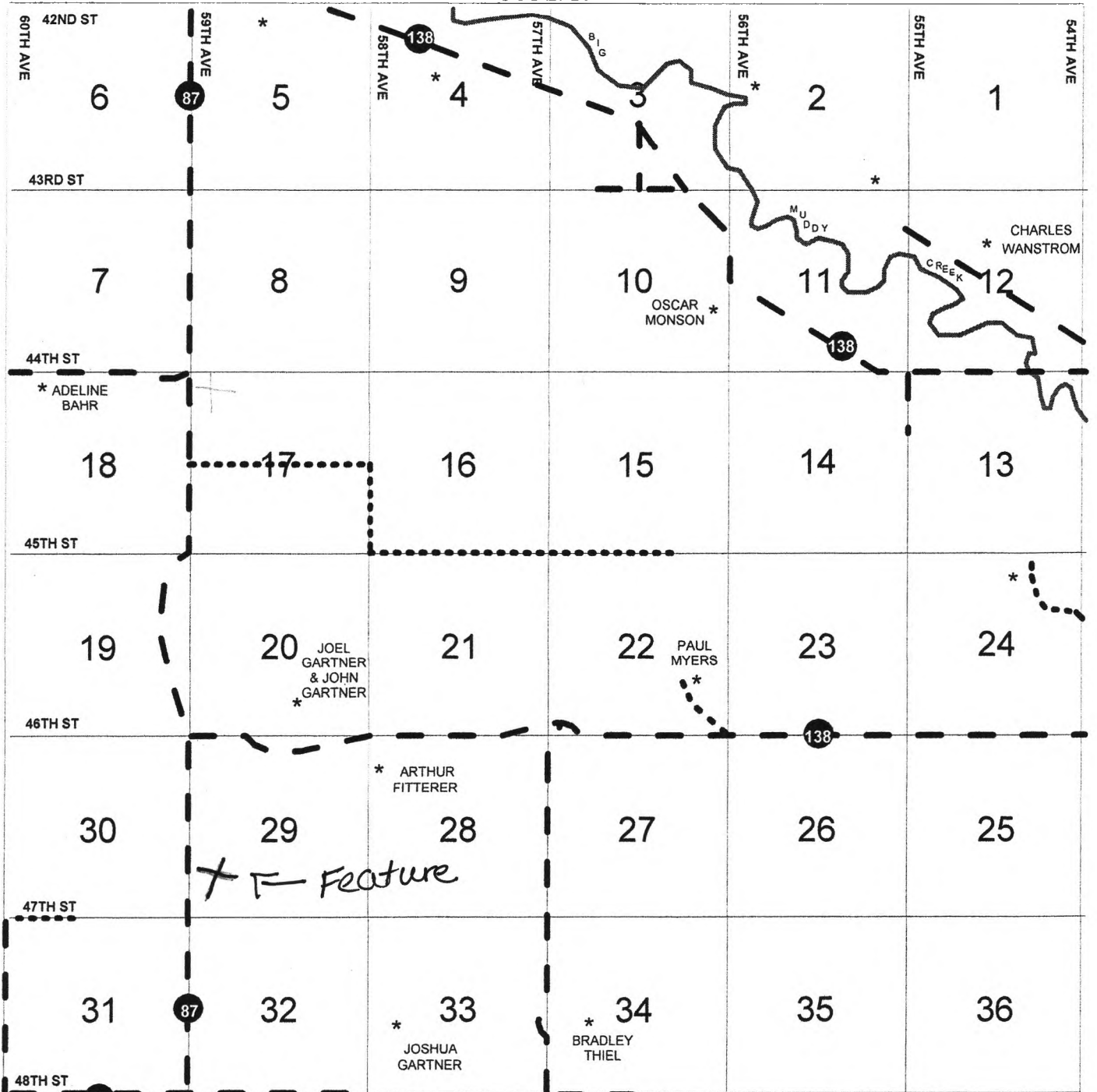
