1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a large building now called Big Heart Lodge. It was a school years ago, the size would make me wonder if it might have been a two room school. The building sits on a poured concrete basement. I saw one opening in the basement on the east side. The roof of the school and entry are covered with metal sheeting. A yellow brick chimney sits at the peak on the east end of the school. At the west end of the roof there is a flag pole. There is a false front at the west end of the roof, above the hip roofed entry. The soffits are open.

The siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch wood corner trim with white paint. The main entry is located at the west end of the building, a solid core door is reached by 5 wood steps to a porch. There is one screened double hung window to the south of the door. A sign above the entry likely had letters on it but it has weathered away. On the south side of the building there is a plywood door reached by several wood steps. Four double hung windows with screening over them are located on both the north and south walls. One more window is on the east end of the building. A light fixture near the west entry door and wires on the north side of the school indicate electricity.

Was not able to go inside this building.
