1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school on a wood planking foundation. The gable roof of the school and the half hip roof of the entry are covered with ribbed metal sheeting. The soffits are closed and there is no chimney. The building measures 24 feet north to south and 16 feet east to west with the entry measuring 8 feet north to south by 12 feet east to west.

There is a wide trim board running under the soffits at both peak ends of the school. The remainder of the siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch corner trim. There are attic vents on both the north and south walls near the roof peak. The 5 panel, locked, wood door gives acces to the entry from a wood porch. Inside the entry there is a 4 panel wood door to the left and another that opens into the school room. Decorative cornices are above the doors and windows. There is are 6 double hung, two over two, windows on the west wall and two more on the south wall, all glass intact. There is one two pane fixed window on the north wall of the entry. The walls are lathe and plaster with a picture rail on all walls. The ceiling is wallboard. There are two small blackboards, one on the north wall of the school and one near the north end of the east wall. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood. There is no wainscot or electricity. There are some student desks as well as a teacher desk, some books and other school items.

The school was built in 1917 in the Arvada School district, it was operational until 1938.






