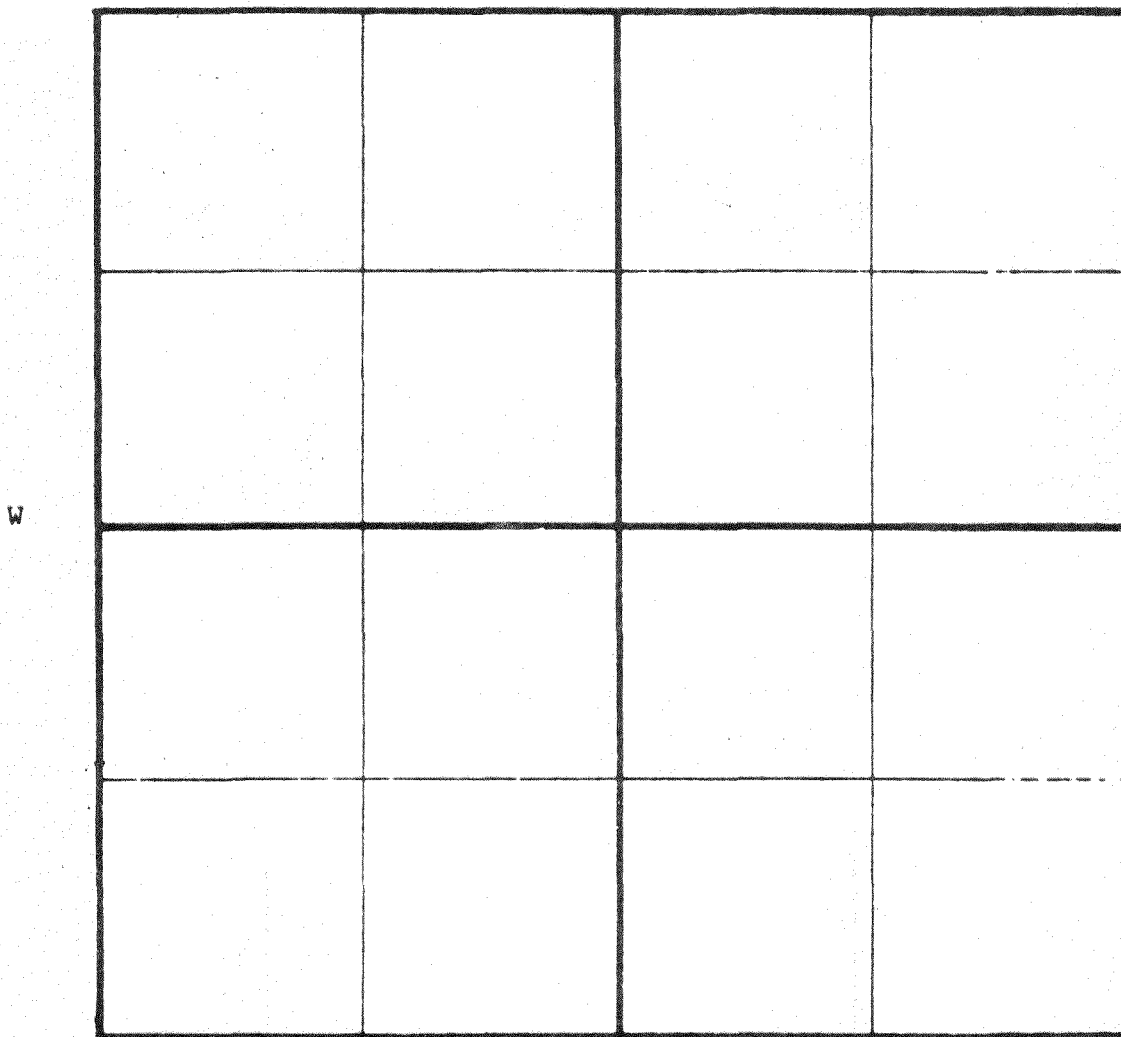

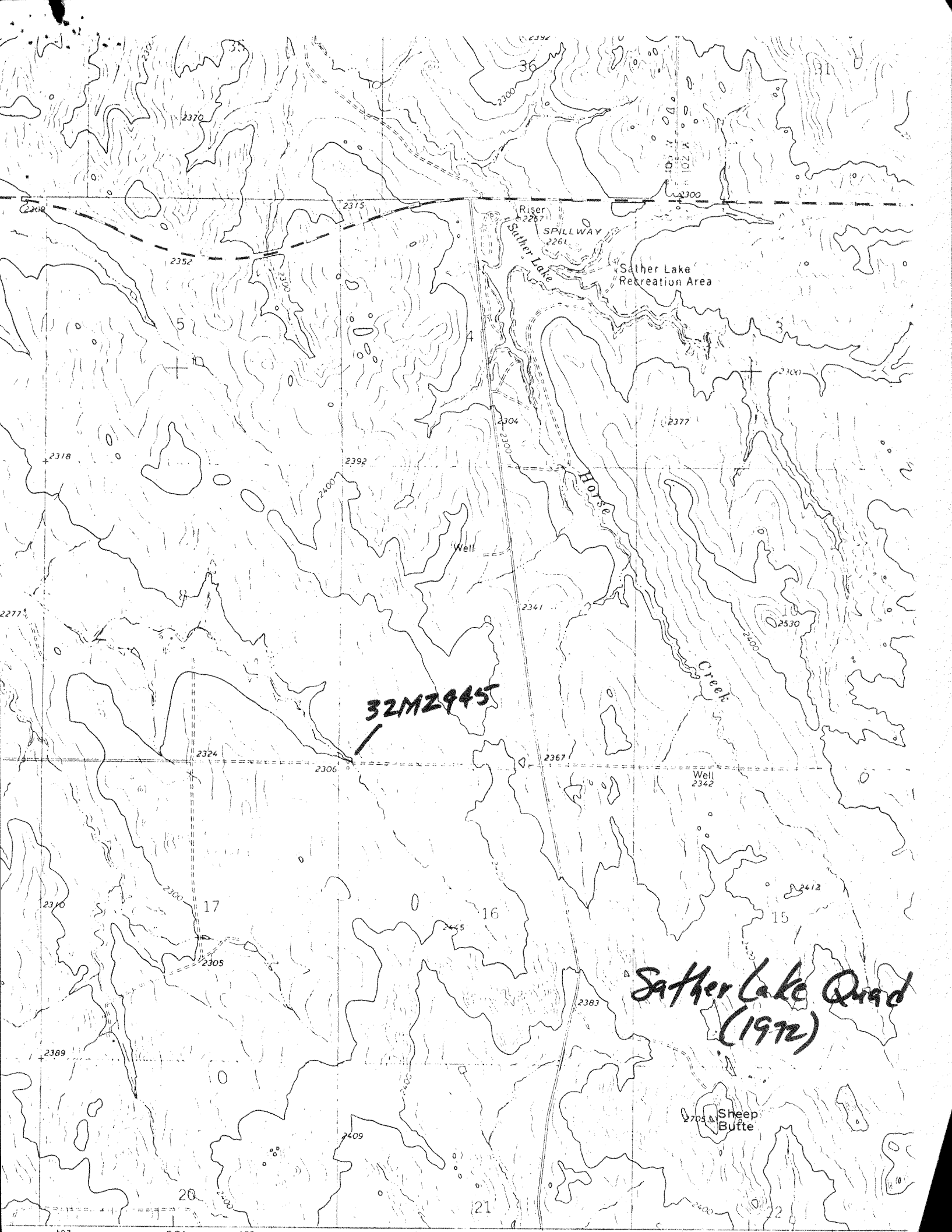
Building is still standing and in good condition. Roof is peaked about 20 feet high. Building is 25' X 15' and sitting on a rock - mortar foundation.

North side has 5, 3' X 5' windows. South and east sides have no windows. Door and two side windows on west side. Door is 3' X 8' with two small 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' X 1' windows over it. Door is gone - frame remains. Two windows are 2' X 2'.

Small cupboard in the southwest corner. Coat hooks along the west side.

Chimney and wood burning potbelly stove to the south of center near the east wall. Chimney center of east wall.

All construction frame - floor is frame. Ceiling gone - once at 10'. The bell tower is still on west side. Frame and tin square temple type top. Flat post still off the top.

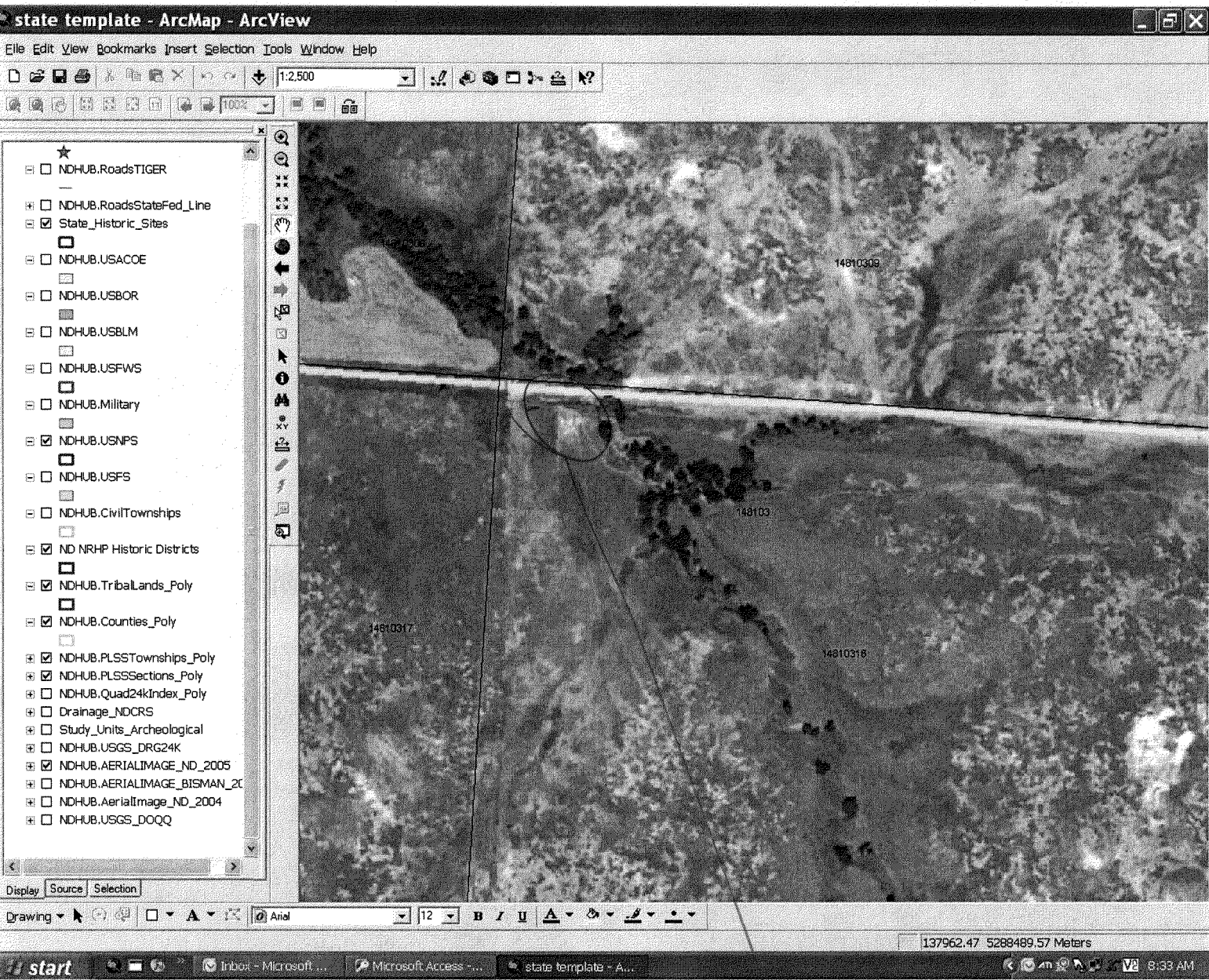
