The feature is a one room prairie school on a poured concrete foundation. The gable roof is covered with wood shakes with a flag pole at the east end of the peak. There is an entry on the east of the school with a shed roof covered with wood shakes. The exterior chimney bricks are gone. The soffits are closed. The main part of the school building measures 16 feet north to south and 28 feet east to west.

A rake board begins the siding under the eaves at either end of the school. The remainder of the siding is 4 inch wood lap with 4 inch vertical corner trim. Some of the siding is falling away. There is no paint left on the school. There is a entry on the east end of the school with a south facing door opening reached across a concrete pad. The door is broken. There are two window openings in the entry, one east and the other north, with no framing and no glass. Four double hung window openings run along the south wall with a bit of framing and no glass. The floor in the school is tongue and groove hardwood, some pieces have buckled and holes make it unsafe. The walls and ceiling are finished with wallboard. The outline of the blackboard remains on the north wall. Electricity was present at some point with the base of ceiling lights remaining.
