1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is likely a two room prairie school on a poured concrete foundation. The mansard roof of the school and two hip roof dormers are covered with asphalt shingles laid on top of wood shakes. The top edges of the roof slopes are covered with metal sheet. There is one flag pole on the dormer above the north door. A large red brick chimney is located on the west slope of the roof.

The siding begins with a rake board under the eaves on all sides of the school. The remainder of the siding is 4 inch wood lap with metal corner trim finished with a water board. On the north side there are 4 large covered windows with a side sliding door near the west end of the wall. It looks like two windows were removed to install the door. On the south side there are 6 large covered windows. There are two 5 panel wood entry doors on the east side. To either side of each door are small covered windows. The south entry door has a hip roof portico supported by wood posts at the outer corners, affording some protection. There are dormers on the roof above both doors with covered window openings. The north door portico is not there. There is a plywood door in the middle of the west wall.
