The feature is a simple woodframed one room school on a mixture of concrete, rocks and blocks for foundation. It was previously located in Bergen county, moved to this location for use as a warming house for snowmobilers and trail riders in Osago county. The gable roof of the main body of the school has asphalt shingles over more asphalt shingles. The entry roof is a partial hip roof covered with the same material as the main body. The eaves are finished with painted soffit boards. There is a newer, metal chimney on the south facing slope of the roof.

There is a header running under the peak of the either end of the main body of the school. Siding is 6 inch wood lap with 4 inch wood corner trim. There are two double hung windows, with intact glass, on the south side and two covered openings on the north side that were windows at one time. The bottom panes of the south windows are multipane and the top are fixed glass. There is another covered window on the north wall of the entry. There is a 5 panel wood door leading into the entry and another leading into the school proper. The outside step is a wood pallet. The walls and ceiling inside the main body are of various products, some wall board, some paneling and some 6 inch bead board. The floor is tongue and groove hard wood. A fuel oil stove sits in the southeast corner of the main room of the school. There is electricity present as seen by the wiring on the outside and fixtures inside.
