This feature is a simple, wood framed one room school sitting on railroad ties. The building is being used for storage and perhaps was a shed for the school when it was operational. The roof of the school is covered with wood shakes over wood sheathing. The roof is capped with metal with a ball finial on the west end. Several have fallen off. The original chimney is gone as evidenced by the hole at the east end of the building. Another smaller chimney pipe is just to the west of the covered hole. The eaves have a painted board soffit. The school measures 24 feet east to west and 18 feet north to south. The west side of the school shows where an entry used to be attached.

There is a wide wood header under the peaked ends. The siding is 6 inch wood lap with 4 inch corner trim. The siding on the east end is starting to curl away from the building. There is little paint left.

There is a bank of windows on the north side, all covered. Looking at them inside the building shows they are two pane, double hung windows with most of the glass intact. On the south side there are three openings that have been filled in with 6 inch lap siding, to match the rest of that wall. Inside the school the walls and ceiling are wallboard. There is an outline of a blackboard on the south wall, where there was openings at one time. There is no wainscot. There was electricity at some point as there are light fixtures inside the school. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood.

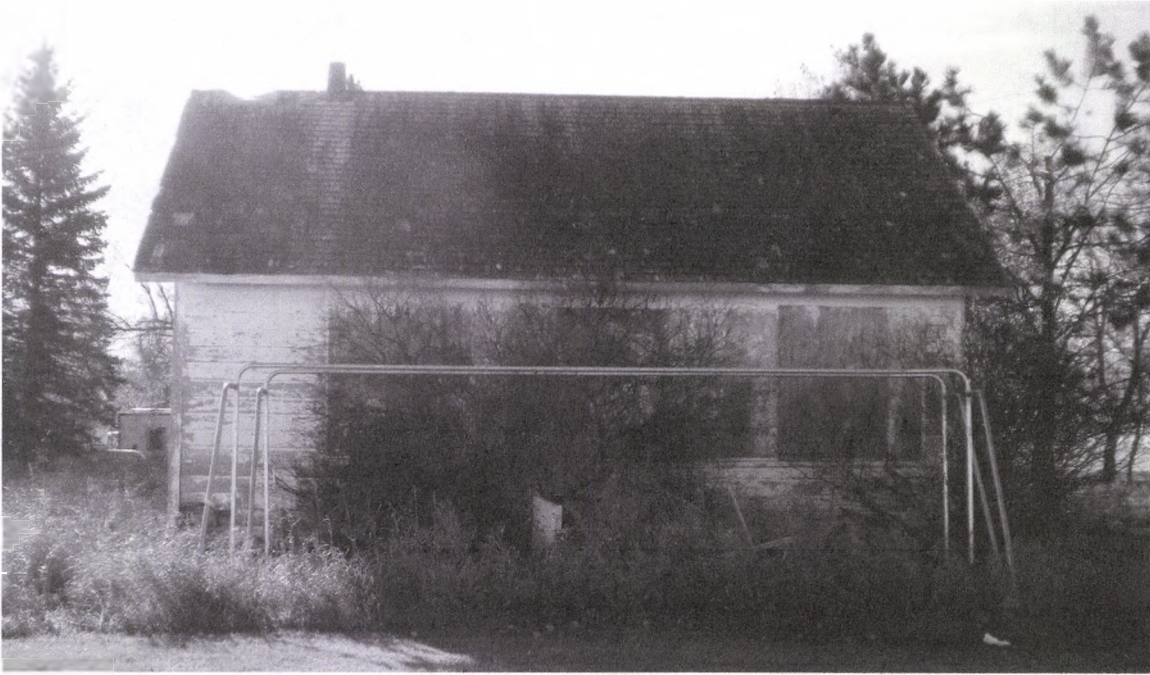

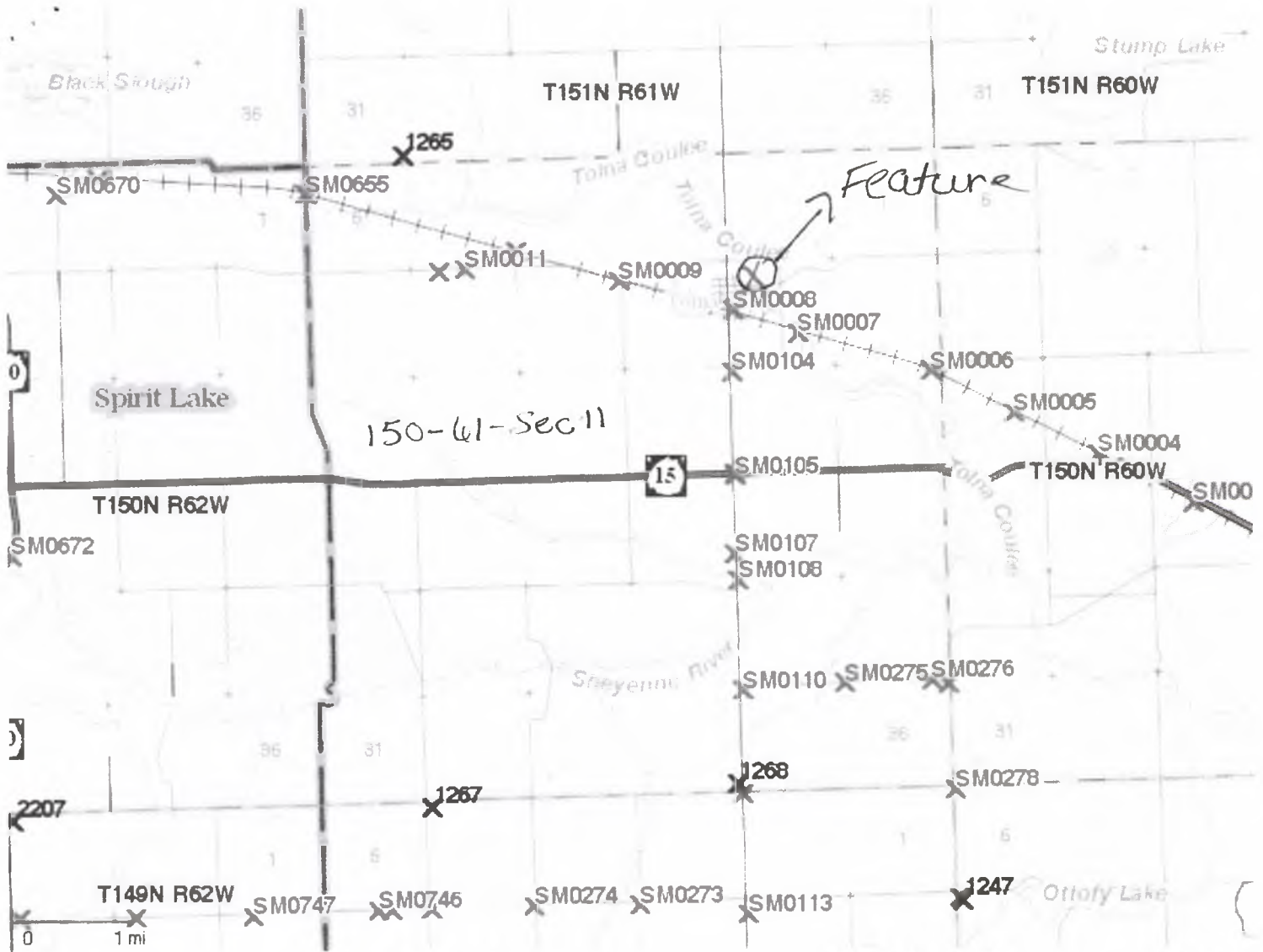
