1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

Grey School 99 has wood shingles on a hip roof with metal ridges and two metal vent pipes from the peak. A blond brick chimney is just southeast of the peak. The eaves have exposed rafter tails. The hip roof over the south entrance is the same materials and style. The siding is narrow lap siding above a painted concrete basement. The east wall has three 3:1 windows on the main level and one window to the basement. The north wall has one 3:1 window near the east corner of the main level and a central 2:2 window to the basement. The west wall has a band of five windows with the three north windows 3:1 and the other two covered. The basement has two two lite windows. The south end has the entrance centered and is an enclosed entrance with a three lite window on the east above a two lite window to the basement and the door has a three lite window above three wood panels. The concrete steps up to the entrance have six steps and then it takes another step to enter the door. The steps have concrete sidewalls. The main body of the south has a 3:1 window on the east of the entrance above a small three lite window in the basement. West of the entrance, the basement has a two lite window. A concrete walk leads to the school from a white picket fence. Trees line the west and north sides of the school. East of the school, facing the highway is a sign that reads "Lamoure Township Grey School 99" in front of a flagpole.

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


