1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a large one room prairie school on a concrete basement. I might question whether or not they used this as a two room school at one point. I was unable to get close to this building as there were dogs.

The gable roofs, main body, addition to the north and the smaller addition to the south all have wood shakes with metal capping and finials. Also on the roof of this building are various pipes, perhaps some for bathroom ventilation. A redbrick chimney is on the west facing slope of the roof nearer the north end of the school. There are no soffits, a trim board finishes the ends of the roofing. The siding planking with no lap involved. The corner trim is 4 inch wood.

There are numerous windows in the school, the west side has a large, multipane double hung window in the north addition, 2 smaller multipane double hung windows just to the south of this. Parts of these windows are covered. Yet a third is to south of the door and it is covered as well. The door, inset opening, is plywood and reached by a set of wooden steps. On the south side of the school there are four shuttered openings that were most likely windows. On the north side of the north addition there is one small and one large multipane double hung window. On the east side of the school there is a bank of 6 very large, multipane (12 over 12) double hung windows with most of the glass intact. The top half of one was shuttered. Below this bank of windows there are 4 more multipane windows in the basement. Some shuttered. Electricity is present with wires running from a near power pole.




