#### 1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school sitting on a concrete block foundation. The school was moved to the Museum lawn in 1968 after closing in 1966. It was originally located several miles south of Wahpeton. The gable roof of the school and entry is covered with asphalt shingles. There is not a chimney. The soffits are closed. The building measures 28 1/2 feet north to south and 16 1/2 feet east to west with the entry measuring 12 feet east to west by 12 feet north to south.

There is a wide trim board at the top of the siding under the peak ends of the roof with the remainder of the siding being 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch wood corner trim. The entry door is three wood panel with a three horizontal pane window at the top. The steps are made of wood. There are three newer double hung, two pane windows on both the east and west walls of the school as well a window on the east side of the entry. These windows all have storm/screen windows. Another 2 panel wood door is located at ground level on the west side of the entry. The entry walls are finished with beadboard. The flooring inside is linoleum over tongue and groove hardwood. The walls and ceiling are composite wallboard. There is a non functioning stove in the school with a lovely decorative metal jacket around it. The school is decorated to represent school days of old. Desks, teachers desk and many other items. There is a blackboard at the south wall as well as between some of the windows. Electricity is present.


