1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prarie school sitting on a concrete block foundation. The hip roof of both the school the and small addition on the south side are covered with asphalt shingles. There is a tall red brick chimney at the south side of the small addition. There is a enclosed bell tower on the east slope of the roof, just about the entry door. The pyramid roof of the bell tower is also covered with asphalt shingle ans there is a flag pole at the peak. The soffits are closed.

The original wood lap siding was all covered with vinyl. The vinyl siding is similar to the original narrow lap siding with vinyl corner trim. All the original windows were covered and there is one shuttered window on the west wall. According to a township member the windows can still be seen inside the school and they have some glass intact. The bank of windows was located on the north wall. There is a solid core entry door on the east side and it is locked. The step to the door is concrete with a pipe railing.

The interior has lathe and plaster on the ceiling and walls. The floor is small slat hard wood and a large portion of that floor, just inside the school door beyond the entry was cut and replaced as it was rotting. There are blackboards on the west and southwest walls with wainscot below. Electricity is present with a light fixture over the door and wires running to the school from a pole.

Today it functions as a township meeting hall.
