The feature is a one room prairie school sitting on a concrete foundation. The school was moved to the Lidgerwood Community Museum location from rural Grant Township. The school is in very good condition. The gable roof is covered with asphalt shingles and the soffits are closed. There is no chimney.

There is a wide trim board on the school wall just under the roof at the peak ends. All other siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch wood corner trim. The entry door to the school has a screen door with a locked steel entry door. There is one double hung window on the north side of the school with a screen window on the outside. A bank of 5 double hung windows is on the south wall along with two more closer to the east end of the school. All windows have screen windows over them. Curtains cover the lower half of the window and shade the upper half. In looking through the windows, the flooring is hardwood plank. The walls and ceiling are lathe and plaster with beadboard wainscot at the lower 1/3 of the walls. There is a blackboard on the north and west wall. An outdoor light fixture over the door and wires on the south wall give evidence of electricity. There are two doors entering the school from the coat room located at the east end of the school.

According to school records the school was built in 1897 and closed in 1946.

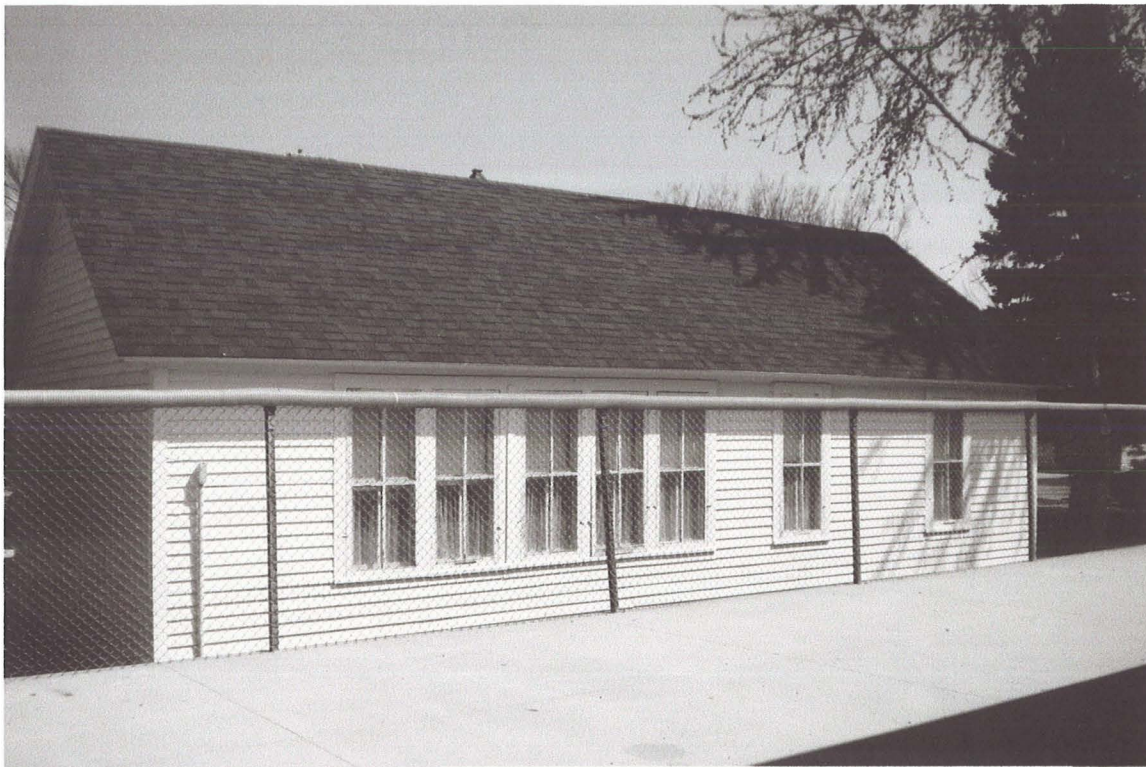

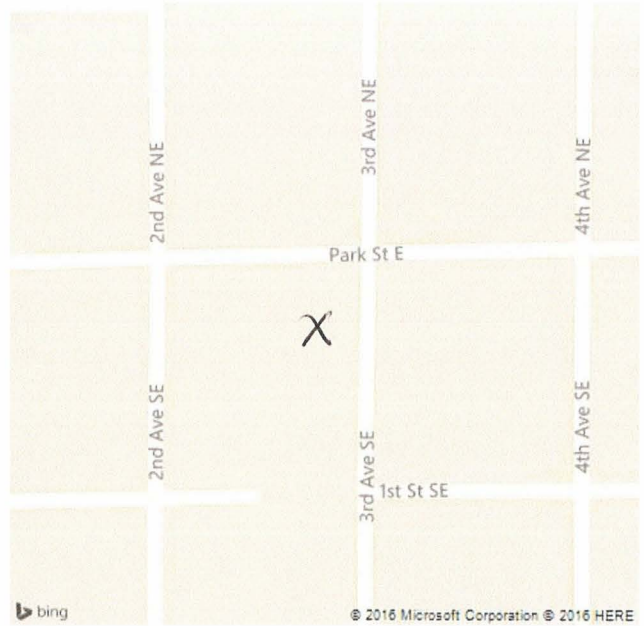
