1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school sitting right on the dirt. It was moved into this farm yard for various uses the last of which was to raise hogs. The gable roof had wood shakes with metal capping and finials. The soffits are closed and the chimney is gone.

The siding starts with a rake board under the eaves on the peak ends. The rest of the siding is 6 inch wood lap with 4 inch corner trim and some of both are gone. There is no paint left on the school. There were 3 double hung windows on the east and west walls with two more double hung windows on the north side. Some framing and a bit of glass remains. The blackboards are gone. There is no entry or coat room as the interior was totally stripped out for farm use. A four panel wood door is on the south end of the school with a transom window above it. Electricity was present at some point.


4. Description of Access and Site Setting:


