1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a large, one room prairie school on a foundation of rocks in cement. The gable roof is covered with wood shakes, metal capping and finials. The north addition shed roof is also covered with wood shakes. There is a red brick chimney on the north slope of the wall close to the east end. The soffits are open. The school measures 36 feet east to west and 20 feet north to south while the addition measures 6 feet by 20 feet. A gabled roof covers a portico at the entrance. A flag pole can be seen at the southeast corner of the school.

A rake board begins the siding at the peak ends of the school. The rest of the siding is 6 inch wood lap with 4 inch wood corner trim. Two wood steps take you to the portico at the entrance to the school. Wood columns at the outside corners help to support the roof. A solid core door gives entry to the school. You step into the coatroom and all the walls in here are covered with pressed tin. There is one double hung window on the east wall of the entry. Coat hooks run along the east wall at two different heights. There are two doors leading from the entry, one (two panel wood) goes to the left into the school room and another (5 panel wood) goes to the north into a large alcove off the school room, it looks like this area was used for the wash room. Another double hung window is in the alcove on the east wall. The school room has 6 large multipane double hung windows along the south wall with intact glass. All have screen windows and most have remnants of window shades. The floor throughout is tongue and groove hardwood. The walls in the school are wallboard with a wide trim board at the floor. The ceiling has acoustical tile. Light fixtures and switches indicate electricity. There are wood framed blackboards on two walls, one on the north wall at the west end and another on most of the west wall. A collection of maps hangs next to the north blackboard. The addition on the north side was used for a small kitchen. A small window located just to the left of the addition door was used as a pass through for children getting their lunch. The wall at the back (east) of the class room has a built in shelf unit for books. This school was closed in 1950.
