1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school sitting on a poured concrete foundation. The school was moved to Lake Upsilon when the Warner-Hutchinson School burned. It was next moved into St. John to reside at the Rolette County Museum. The roof of the school is finished with asphalt shingles. A red brick chimney sits at the south peak of the roof. The soffits are open. The school measures 18 feet by 33 feet with the shed/entry measuring 8 feet by 18 and the classroom measuring 25 feet long.

There is a wood ramp leading to the 6 panel wood entry door. The siding is vinyl with 4 inch vinyl corner trim. There is a coatroom inside the entry door. Yet another wood door leads into the school proper. The walls in the school are wallboard with wide trim at floor level. The floor is covered with tile. the ceiling is wallboard as well. There are 5 two over two, double hung windows on the southwest side of the school room. They have glass intact and are decorated with a short curtain at the bottom and window shades from the top. There is another window at the south side of the southeast end of the school. A small window with three panes on top and a single window on the bottom is located in the entry. No waiscot in this school but they do have electricity. A blackboard is located on the northeast wall of the school. The school is furnished with desks, teachers desk, a wood burning stove, many books and much more.

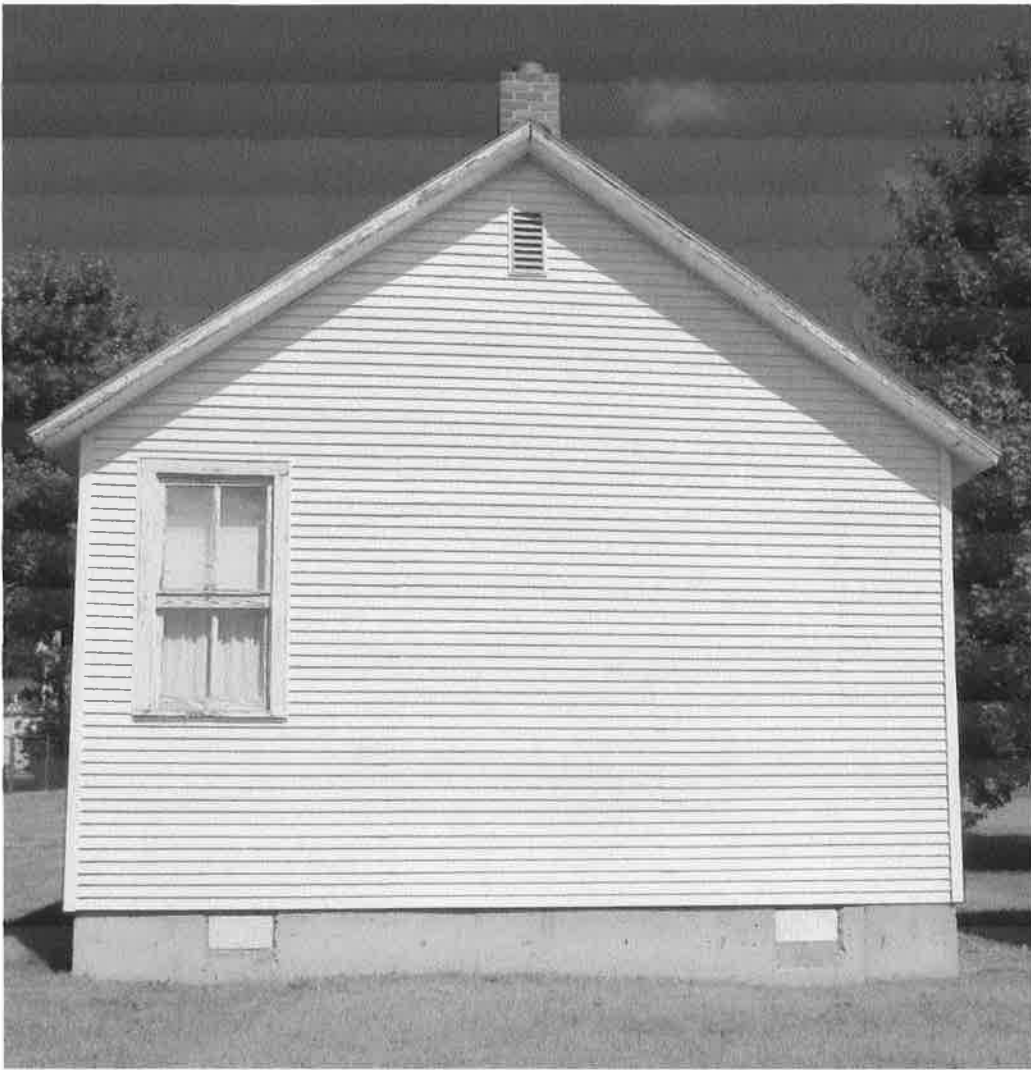
