1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

This feature is a one room, wood framed prairie school houe. It has been move to a farm for storage/garage/shop use. The building sits on a concrete foundation and the east end has been changed to accomodate an overhead garage door and a small walk in door. The building measures 32 feet 4 inches east to west and 22 feet 4 inches north to south. The name of this school is Goodrich school and it is believed to have been in the town of Goodrich. There are no school records prior to 1912 for Sheridan County as it was part of McClean County. It is believed to have been built in 1912.

The roof of the building is covered with shakes and they are mostly intact. There is a metal piece at the roof peak near the south end covering where a chimney was most likely located. There is a metal ridge cap running the length of the roof with finials at each end. The outside walls are covered with 6 inch lap siding with 6 inch wood trimming the corners. A wide header board can be seen on all four side of the school.

There are windows on both the north and south sides, three on each side for the main body of the school and then another full length one on the west side of what I suspect is the entry area and a small opening to the north, also in the area of the entry. The smaller opening might have been access for fuel. The windows in the main body of the school have intact glass and most are covered with hinged shutters. Most of the exterior is in need of paint. On the west side there is an entry door. The door is wood and sports an old looking metal door knob.

Inside the school the original tongue and groove hardwood floor is still intact. The walls are mostly still in place and are lathe and plaster in the main body of the school and Ibead board in what was used for an entry. There is waiscoting on the bottom portion of the walls. The interior wall between the entry and main body has been removed. Blackboards can be see between the windows on both the north and south sides. Pressed metal ceiling tiles over lathe cover much of the ceiling. At the edges there is a molded metal cornice. The building has electricity as evidenced by light fixtures inside the building.






