The feature is a one room prairie school on a poured concrete foundation. The hip roof and shed roof are covered with wood shakes, the gable roof of the dormer is covered with asphalt shingles. There is metal capping at the peak of the hip roof with finials at both ends. There is metal capping on all the hips as well. There is a red brick chimney on the east facing slope of the roof just west of the dormer. The dormer most likely was the bell tower, has two openings to the east with rounded tops. At the peak of the dormer roof is a flagpole. The building measures 34 feet west to east and 20 feet north to south with the shed measuring 10 feet by 10 feet.

There is a wide trim board under the soffits on all four side sof the school. The remainder of the siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch wood corner trim. The shed has a small window opening on the north side, glass intact and a door on the south side that opens into a room with no finished walls or ceiling, likely used for fuel storage. There are two double hung, two over two, smaller windows with glass on the east wall to either side of the entry door. The south wall has 6 large double hung, two over two, windows with storms, again glass intact. The entry door is a broken wood door with a transom above it. The transom has two rows of 5 small panes of glass in it. The entry foyer has two 5 panel doors to either side as you enter, the door right goes to a coat room and the door to the left goes into the school proper. There are decorative cornices above the doors and all the windows. The large windows have shades that pull down from the top of the window frame. The walls and ceiling are lathe and plast with wainscot at the bottom third. A blackboard runs along the west wall and corner to more on about 1/4 of the north wall. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood. There is a furnace sitting near the east interior wall. Conduit and light fixtures suggest electricity.
