1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a simple, wood framed one room school sitting on a concrete foundation. The building was moved to this location to be use for storage for the city school. The roof is covered with wood shakes over wood sheathing. Some of the shakes are missing. There is a crumbling brick chimney at the north end of the peak. Metal capping seals the peak. The building measures 18 feet east to west and 36 feet north to south. The eaves have closed soffits.

There is a wide header under the eaves at both peaked ends. The siding is wood lap with 4 inch wood corner trim. On the south end there is a circle about the door, covered with wood. Two large doors were added to the south side of the building to give access for storage and/or lawn mowers. There is a walk in entry door at the west end of the south side. It most likely led into an entry but walls inside were removed. There is another doorway about 8 feet in, near the west wall, and it would have led into the main body of the school. The windows are covered with plywood from the outside, glass mostly intact when viewed from the inside. They are 2 pane, double hung. At the top of the outside covering are attractive cornices. The walls are of lathe and plaster with wainscoting in the main room of the school. Blackboards remain on the east and north walls. The ceiling is lathe and plaster and much of it is falling into the building. There is an electric light over the door on the south, electricity was there at some point.




