1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

This feature is a large, wood framed one room prairie school on a basement of poured concrete and concrete blocks. The roof of the school is covered with asphalt shingles that are beginning to fail, some missing on the south slope of the roof. There is a large crumbling chimney on the north slope at the east end of the school. A bathroom pipe can be see at the west end of the north slope. The eaves have soffits closed with beadboard, starting to fall away. At each of two doors there is a porch roof with decorative triangle supports holding them up. Each gable roof has some wood shakes remaining along, a short piece of metal capping with ball finials seal both porches. The underside of the porch roofs are finish with beadboard.

The building measures 40 feet east to west and 24 feet north to south.

There is a wide header under the eaves on all four side of the school. The siding is 6 inch wood lap with metal corner caps. The entire north side of the building has no windows and one 5 panel wood door for entry from the back. The east side has three covered windows, I did not get into this part of the building. The west side has three covered windows as well, from the inside I can see they were multipane double hung windows. There is a bank of 5 large, multipane double hung windows, all covered. Some glass remains. The entry at the west end of the school is reached by concrete steps to a concrete porch with wood box side walls, about 2 1/2 feet tall, finished with wood lap and metal corner caps. This door is broken and hanging open. The entry on the east is the same design at the other and this door is covered and locked. Inside the space at the west end of the school is the coat room with hooks on the west wall. There is a door leading to the bathrooms in the northwest corner. The main body of the school is through a door to the right. The school is full of junk. It is a large room with high walls of lathe and plaster with a decorative railing running around the room about 2 feet from the ceiling. The ceiling is also lathe and plaster and much of it is falling into the school. There are two blackboards in the room, one on the east wall and another on the north wall. On the east wall of the school room there is a door leading into a room on the end. It is quite small so doubt the had two classrooms.

There is electrical wiring on the outside of the building on the west side as well as a light fixture near the east most entrance.


