#### 1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

Homer School or Homer Township Hall is a long, rectangular building that is comprised of two (what is assumed to be) one room school buildings combined to make a larg township hall. The building is sitting on concrete footings and concrete bloc with a partial basement about the middle of the building. The furnace is located down there. The gable roof of this building is covered with asphalt shingles which cover the building from west to east and do not show where the buildings were connected. At the peak of the roof near the west end is a large piece of metal covering what was mostly likely the chimney home. The chimney today is a newer concrete chimney running up the outside wall on the south side of the building. An addition on the west end of the building as well as a small shed entry on the south both have sloped, shed roofing covered with asphalt shingles. The soffits are closed and there are eaves troughs on the north and south sides with downspouts at the corners. There is a wide trim board under the roof peaks at both ends of the main part of the building.

The siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch corner trim. It is easy to see where the two buildings were cobbled together as the siding shows a seam. There is also a seam where the west addition is connected. The windows are a combination of styles. On the east end and in the main body of the school the windows (2 east, 5 north and 4 south) have been replaced with smaller, double hung windows with intact glass in the space and the top is filled in with plywood. The west entry has covered windows on the north and south walls. There are two small windows with 4 fixed panes in each on the south addition. There are three entry doors into the school, the main entry door on the east side of the school is a solid core door that leads to a new, 6 panel door, the door on the west side is 5 panel wood and the door into the south addition is wood planking. The south entry is where the stairs are for the basement, it is kind of creepy. There is a newer, solid core door that goes into the school from the basement entry. All the exterior doors are kept locked. Another 5 panel wood door stands open between the west addition and the main body of the school. The walls in the school are all beadboard, some narrow and some wider. The main room is painted a combination of green on the lower 2/3 of the wall and yellow at the top. The west addition is painted white. The ceiling is also a combination of wide and narrow beadboard. There is a stage (16 feet wide at the front edge and it is 12 feet deep) at the west end of the main body with a door at the middle of the back of the stage that goes into the west addition. The floor throughout is narrow, tongue and groove hardwood. Electricity is present with ceiling lights and baseboard heat.

The building measures 70 feet east to west and 22 feet north to south. Inclusive of all but the south addition. That is 4 feet north to south and 12 feet east to west.




