1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a large one room prairie school sitting on a concrete basement/foundation. It was moved into LuVerne to be used as a bar. The hip roof of this building is covered with asphalt shingles. There is a newer, concrete chimney on the east slope of the hip roof. The soffits are closed and finished with beadboard. there is an addition to the west and there is a large vent in the roof of this part of the building. The entry gable roof is also covered with asphalt shingles. This building measures 46 feet north to south and 28 feet east to west. The entry is 9 feet deep by 22 feet wide. The addition at the real is 12 feet deep by 28 feet.

The siding on the main body of the school as well as the entry is 4 inch wood lap with metal corner capping. The addition has verticle composite siding. There is a door on the west all of the addition. All of the original windows are gone. There are two sets of slider windows on the east wall of the building and a couple very small windows either side of the new entry door. One set of slider windows is on the south wall of the building. There was no access to the building. Electricity is present as evidenced by wires and conduit on the north side of the building.
