The feature is a one room prairie school moved to the current location from Carter Township near Flaxton. The school sits on a poured concrete foundation. It is part of a pioneer village in Kenmare ND. The roof is finished with metal sheeting and there is no exterior chimney. The soffits are closed.

The siding begins with a rake board under the peaked roof ends. The remainder of the siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch wood corner trim. The school is painted white. There is a ramp leading up to the small entry. A 5 panel wood door with a transom window at the top give entry to the school. The floor in the entry and the school is tongue and groove hardwood. There are three double hung, 2 over 2, windows on both the north and south sides of the school with intact glass. A four panel wood door leads from the entry into the school proper. The walls in the school are lathe and plaster with wainscot. The ceiling is finished with beadboard. There are blackboards either side of the stove pipe/chimney on the west wall. There are desks, a stove with pipe hooked up to the remnants of the chimney, maps, books and more furnishings that speak of earlier times in a one room school. This school closed in 1948 and was moved to the village in 1974.

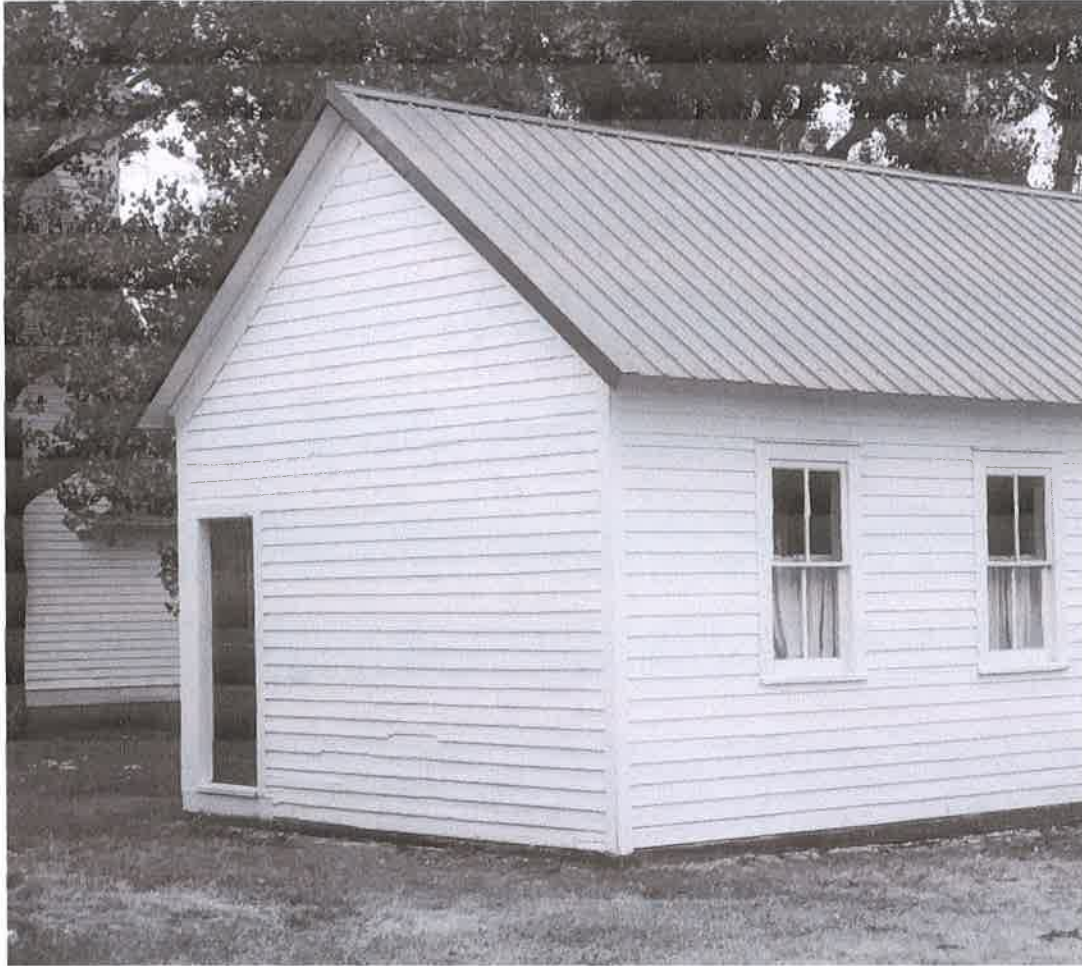

The feature is a one room prairie school moved to this location in 2007 from Spencer Township in Ward County. It is located on a poured concrete foundation. The roof is metal sheeting, installed in 2017. There is no chimney. The soffits are closed. There is a bell tower at the north end of the roof, complete with a bell. The roof of the bell tower is also covered with metal sheeting.

The siding begins with a rake board leading to the 6 inch wood lap siding. 6 inch wood corner trim completes the siding. It was all painted red in 2017. There is an entry at the north end of the school, reached by a ramp to the wood porch. A newer, solid core, door with a window at the upper half gives entry to the school. There are fixed pane windows, two vertical panes of glass each, to either side of the entry door. More windows are located on both the east and west sides of the school. There are three, 2 over 2, double hung windows with intact glass on each side. Decorative cornices are seen at the top of each window inside with wide decorative trim on the sides as well as at the bottom of the windows. Decorative cornices and trim also surround the school room door from the entry. The walls are grooved wall board with a wide trim board at the floor. The floor is hard wood in the entry and then hard wood covered with tile in the school room. The sloped ceiling is also finished with the grooved wall board. Electricity is present. There is a blackboard across the entire southeast wall of the school.

This school is furnished with desks, books, maps and other items that were common in these one room schools.

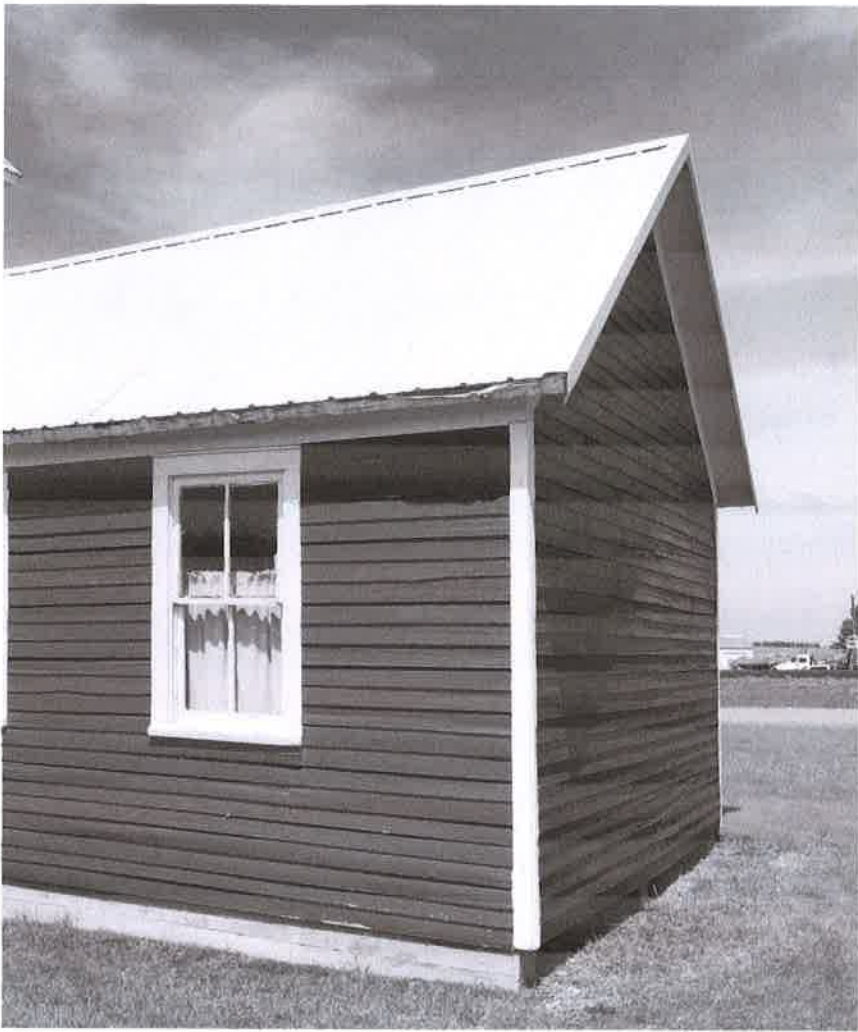

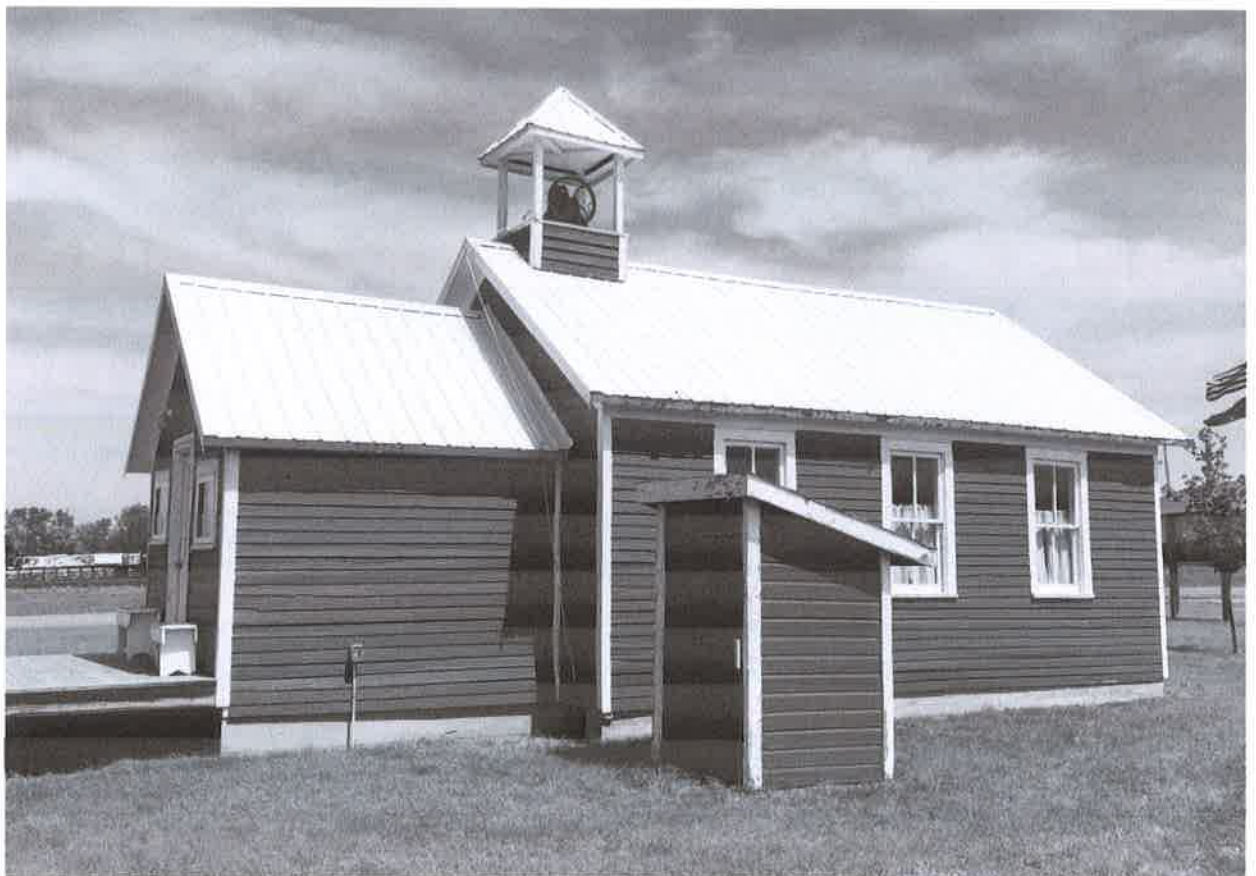
