The feature is a one room prairie school on a concrete and rock foundation. The school consists of an entry to the south, the main body of the school and a shed addition to the north. The hip roof entry and the gable roof of the main body has asphalt shingles. The shed roof at the north end has wood shakes. There is a red brick chimney at the north end of the peak of the school roof. There is a flag pole at the south end of the peak of the roof. The soffits are closed. The building measures 34 feet north to south and 16 feet east to west. The entry measures 12 feet east to west by 6 feet north to south.

There is a wide trim board under the soffits on either peak end of the roof as well as around the entry. The siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch corner trim. A concrete step leads to the entry where a broken 5 panel wood door gives access. The entry has two small fixed pane windows (one is boarded up) to either side of that entry door. All of the windows and doors have wide, decorative cornices both in and out. The entry walls and ceiling are all covered with beadboard, painted white. The main body of the school has walls and ceiling sheet with beadboard painted yellow and there is wainscot made of 4 inch lumber and painted blue. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood. There are three double hung, two over two, windows on both the east side and west side. Some of the windows are covered with plywood on the inside. There is a fuel oil stove in the middle of the school room and some of the stove pipe is still hanging from the ceiling. There are blackboards in the school, one on the east half of the south wall and another on the east half of the north wall. There is door opening on the north wall of the school that goes into the north addition. That addition has an exterior door opening on the west side, a small window opening and there is a boarded up opening on the north wall, perhaps a fuel door. The addition has no finished walls, it is planking on the wall and roof. There are light switches and light fixtures suggesting electricity.

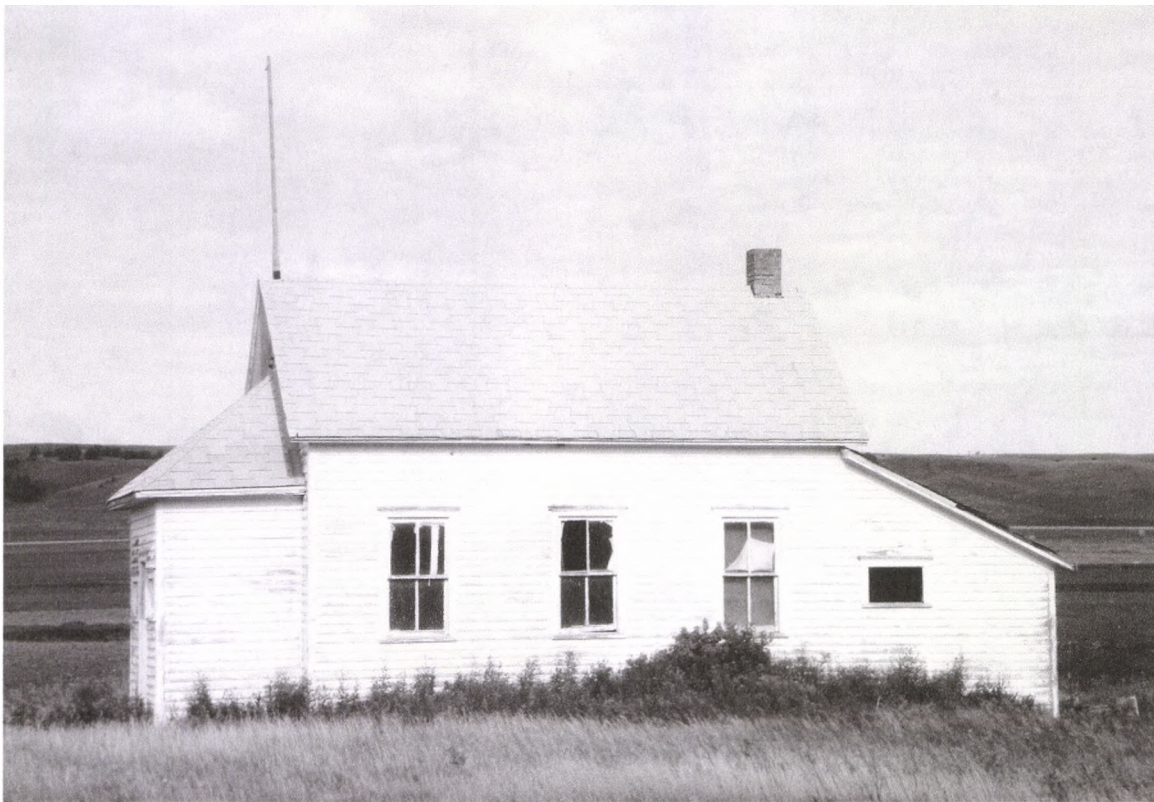
