#### 1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room school on a poured concrete foundation. The hip roof of the main body of the school is sort of covered with asphalt shingles over wood shakes and the half hip roof of the entry is covered with asphalt shingles as well. There is a tall, red brick chimney on the north slope of the roof. The soffits are closed. The building measures 24 feet north to south and 22 feet east to west with an entry that measures 5 feet north to south by 10 feet east to west.

There is a wide trim board under all side of the school under the soffits to begin the siding. The remainder of the siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch wood corner trim. There is an entry with a broken 5 panel wood door. There are three windows on both the west and east walls of the school, double hung with no glass and little framing. The interior walls and ceiling are covered with beadboard and there is wainscot of the same material, installed vertically as apposed to the walls which are have horizontal beadboard. There are blackboards on the north wall and between the windows on the east wall. None on the west wall. Light fixtures would suggest electricity. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood.
