1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school on a poured concrete foundation. The gable roof of the school is mostly covered with wood shakes with metal capping and finials. The half hip roof of the entry is covered with asphalt shingles. The soffits are closed. There is no chimney. The building measures 32 feet north to south and 16 feet east to west. The entry measures 10 feet by 8 feet.

There is a wide trim board under the peaked ends of the roof and the remainder of the siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch corner trim. A cement pad leads to the entry. The 5 panel entry door has been repaired and a second door for entry into the school is also a 5 panel wood door in better shape that the first. The entry has bead board on three walls, the main body of the school has similar siding as the rest of the building leading me to think this was added at a later date. There is an a boarded up area on the north side of the school that looks to have been a door, inside the school there is a piece of plywood in this area. There is one shuttered window opening on the south wall of the entry. There are two over two, double hung windows, 4 on the west side and 4 on the east side, and some have glass, some are shuttered and some have framing with no glass. The interior walls of the school are lathe and plaster with no wainscot. The ceiling is covered with beadboard. Light fixtures on the ceiling and conduit and wiring on the north wall suggest electricity. There are blackboards in the school, One on the east half of the north, another on the east wall between the middle two walls and the same on the west wall.
