**1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:**

Haaland Township school district was organized April 21, 1896. One school was built in Haaland Township and Haaland School #2 was built in section 2 of Progress Township. This school would have been built after 1896. It is a wood framed school set on a poured concrete foundation. This school is typical, in size and shape, of one-room schools built during that period. The school was built with two windows facing west and four windows facing north. The entire south wall holds a blackboard that equals 64 square feet. The interior was originally lath and plaster before it was insulated and sheet rocked. There are ceiling tiles covering the original ceiling material. The entry door could very well be the original door.

At one time there was an entry with wooden steps for access. It was torn down after it became rotten. About 2000 the entire building was covered with vinyl siding. The siding goes right over the windows with exception of a small window on the west side of the school.

The school was in session until about 1956. They had a wood burning stove which was later converted to fuel oil. There are ceiling lights, outlets and light switches which indicate the school had electricity.

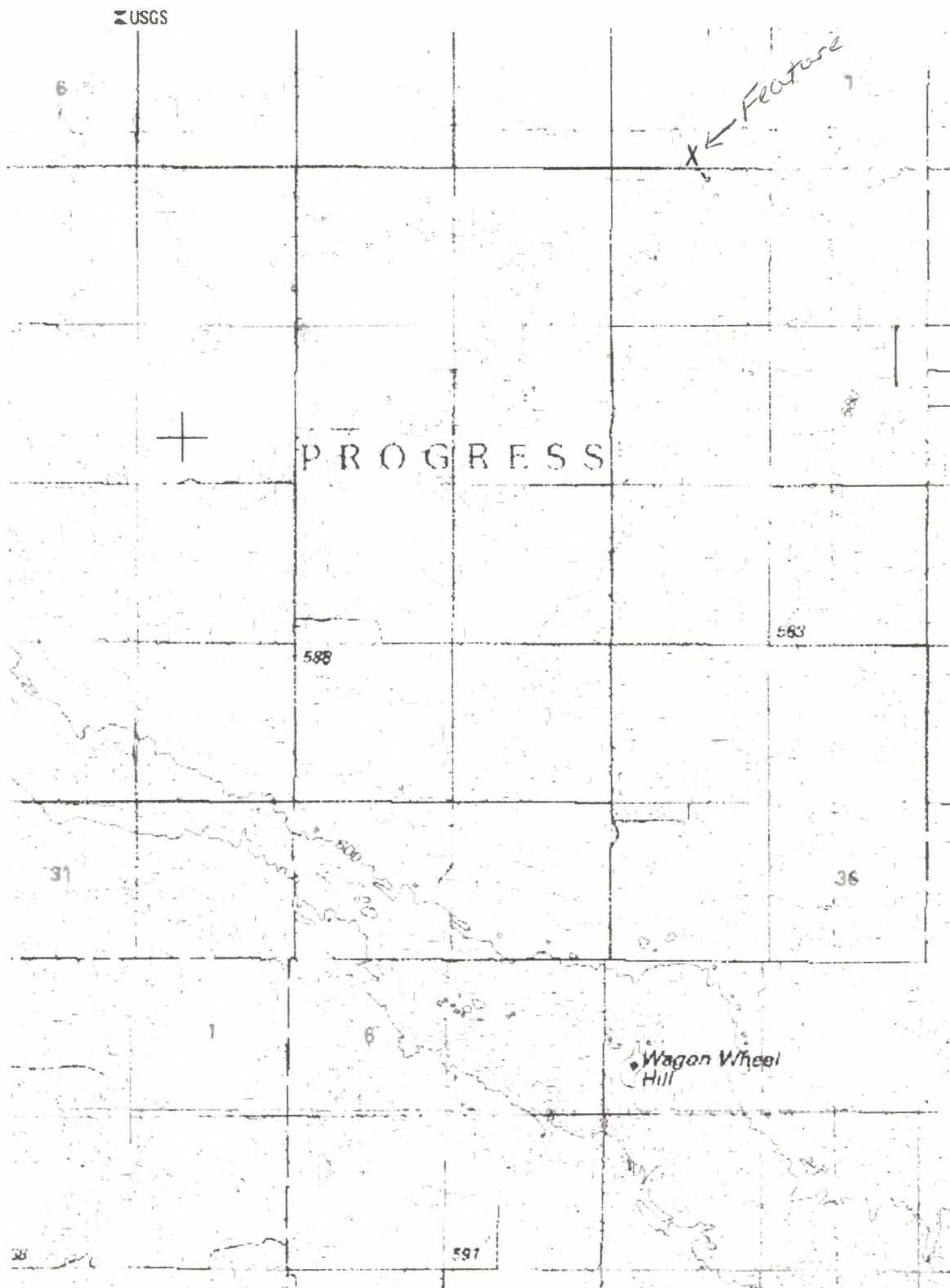

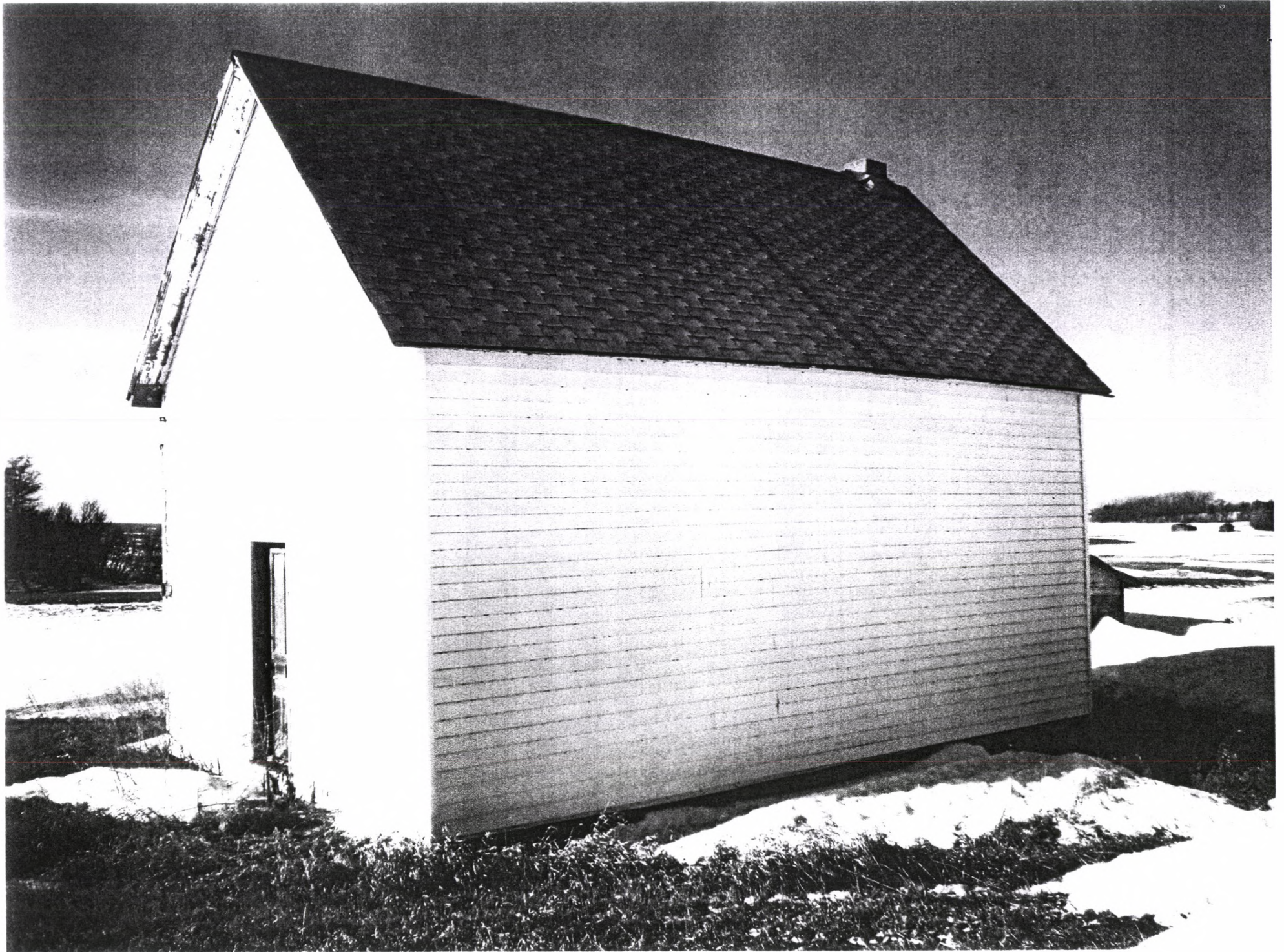




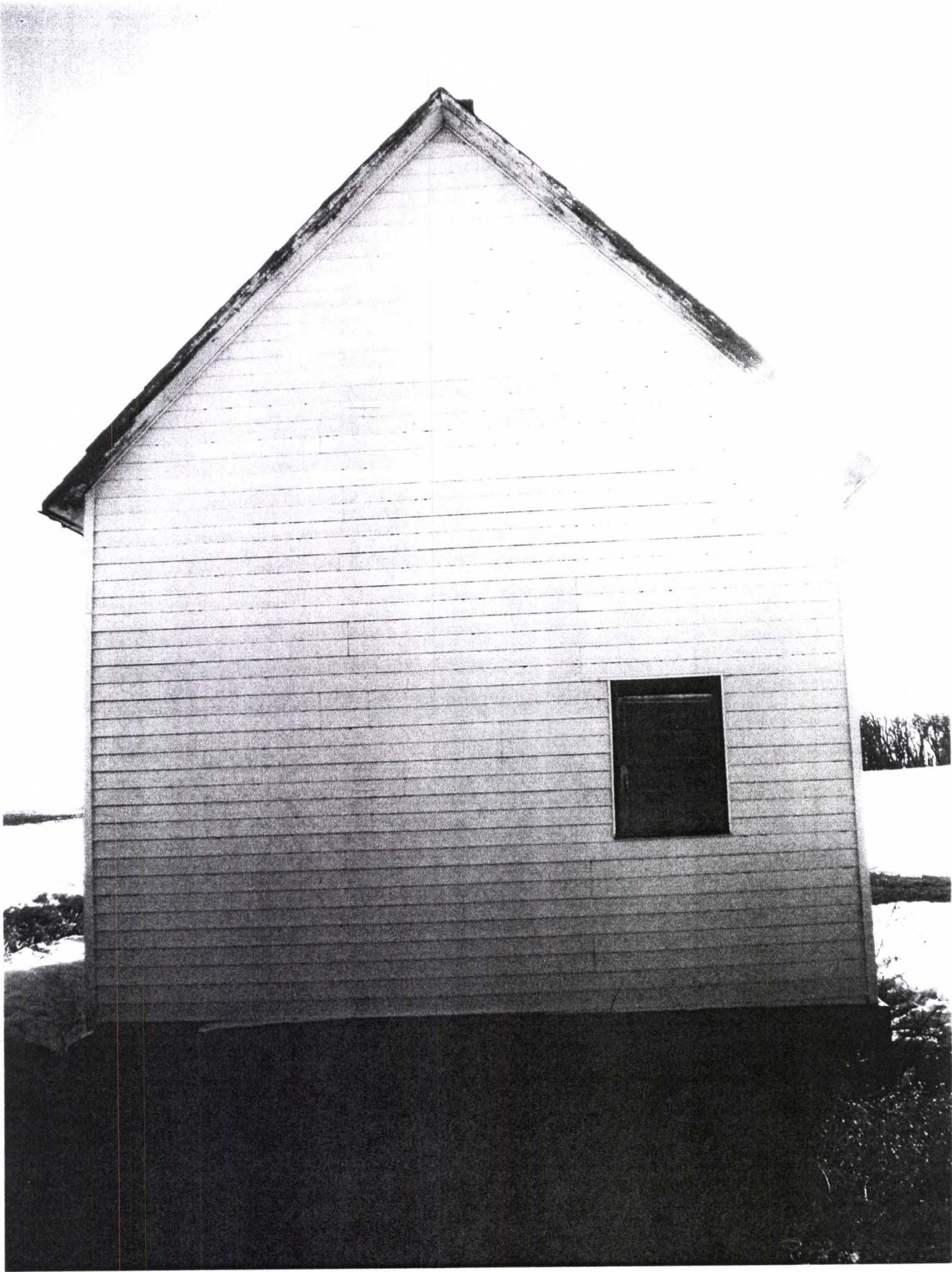
