**1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:**

St. Anna school has been completely refurbished. The wood shakes are new as well as the cupola, which was completely rebuilt. There is a bell in the cupola. A very short brick chimney can be seen on the east slope of the roof toward the front of the school. The siding under the gable roof as it comes to the hip roof is vertical. The remainder of the siding is horizontal lap siding.

The school measures 20' wide by 29 ½ feet long with the small entry measuring 5' by 7'. The entry is very unique with a hip roof and it bumps out from the main building. The steps leading into the school are wood steps. This is new construction. The lights are on at the school in the pictures and you can see the light at the entry. I don't know if the St. Anna School sign above the door is new.

As you enter the school you find yourself in a lovely entry area. To the right are coat hooks and shelving, across from that is a table with a washbasin, water cooler and other items from past school days. There are many lunch boxes on the shelf in the entry as well. The beautiful floors are all sanded and refinished so the wood glows. The walls are lath and plaster and the paint was chosen to match a shade of the old plaster. The ceiling is decorative tin. There are black boards on parts of three walls. The windows are intact with fixed glass windows above the lower one with two windows facing north and 5 windows facing to the east. The glass is not wavy so was probably new. There is small window on the east side in what used to be the area leading to the basement. That room has been left unfinished to show people the structural part of the school. A window in the entry was rebuilt from an old window frame. Two windows on the south side are smaller than the windows in the main body of the school, probably because the roof is lower at the point of the building.

This a beautiful example of an early one-room school, completely furnished with period pieces.

St. Anna School was moved to its present location in 2006. The last year this school was in session was in 1960.
