1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

This school is the second school built in this location. The first school was small and it was moved to another location to serve as a townhall. The school featured here was built sometime after 1917 as one of my resources told me her mother went to the smaller, older school and graduated from 8th grade about 1917.

The school is sits on a concrete block basement. The basement was built to be about 3 feet up from the ground and there are window spaces with glass block for the basement in the foundation. The building has a brick chimney near the peak of the roof. The roof is shingled with asphalt shingles over what looks to be a wood roof. Some of the shingles on the main body of the school are missing while the roof in the kitchen add-on has many holes. The room at the north end of the school was built to house a kitchen to cook simple meals for the students. The families supplied food to the school and the teacher prepared meals.

The outside walls are 3-4 inch lap siding with most of the painted worn away by weather. On the east side it looks like there was a window that might have been a door at one time. The cloak room is on the east side of the main body of the school.

I believe this was one of the last one-room schools in Wells County, closing in 1961. The families fought the closing of the school. In the process of updating the school through the 1940's and 1950's they got electricity and then had the school plumbed for water and indoor bathrooms in the basement. The heat was fuel oil and the fuel tank was located in the basement.

The west wall and the south wall each have 4 sets of what appear to be double hung windows. All but one of the windows is covered with plywood shutters. All the glass is gone in the windows. All the windows have wide windowsills and wide window trim between each window. The lower part of the walls are covered with wainscoating and the upper part are lath and plaster. The ceiling in the building is decorated tin, very pretty and seems very high. There are four lights hanging from the ceiling and one of them still has the white globe on it. The entry to the school is now through the north addition. The door faces east and there are a few steps up to the kitchen area or you can take a left into the coatroom. More steps lead to the basement. I didn't go down there.

Apparently after the school closed a family used the school for a dwelling. Later the east side of the school was opened up and a large sliding door was hung on the bhilding to allow for farm equipment storage.

There is still a flag pole on the tip of the east side but it is leaning to the south these days.






