1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school that sits on a concrete pad. It was moved to this location for use as a storage shed. The hip roof is covered with asphalt shingles. There is a newer, concrete chimney on the north slope of the roof. The soffits are open. The square building measures 24 by 24 feet.

The siding is 6 inch wood lap with 4 inch wood corner trim. The building is painted red with white trim on the corners and around the windows. On the east side there is a wood entry door with two fixed pane windows either side. They are not original to the school. On the south side there is one double hung window window and a sliding door. The west and north walls both have two windows openings, two are covered (one on each side) and two are replacement, fixed pane windows. All glass intact. The floor in a small room in the southeast corner of the building has tongue and groove hardwood, the remainder of the flooring in the building is concrete. The walls and ceiling are mostly lathe, nearly all of the plaster has either fallen off or been removed. The ceiling is metal sheeting. there are no blackboards, wainscot or electrcity. Story has it that the school was at one time used as a teacherage.
