**1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:**

The feature is a one room prairie school on a poured concrete basement. As described previously the hip roof is mostly covered with wood shakes. Metal capping can be seen at the peak and all hips. The bell tower also has wood shakes and it is relatively good shape with no leaning. The soffits are closed. The building measures 36 feet north to south and 20 feet east to west. No chimney remains.

The siding starts with a frieze board all side of the school. Siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch wood corner trim and some of the siding is falling away. No intact window and door openings. The window openings on the west side show some framing and the windows were very large with transom windows at the top. There was an entry inside the door opening. The interior walls have little plaster left on the lathe and the lathe is beginning to break away as well. There is a picture rail near the ceiling. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood. The basement has much debris. No blackboards remains.

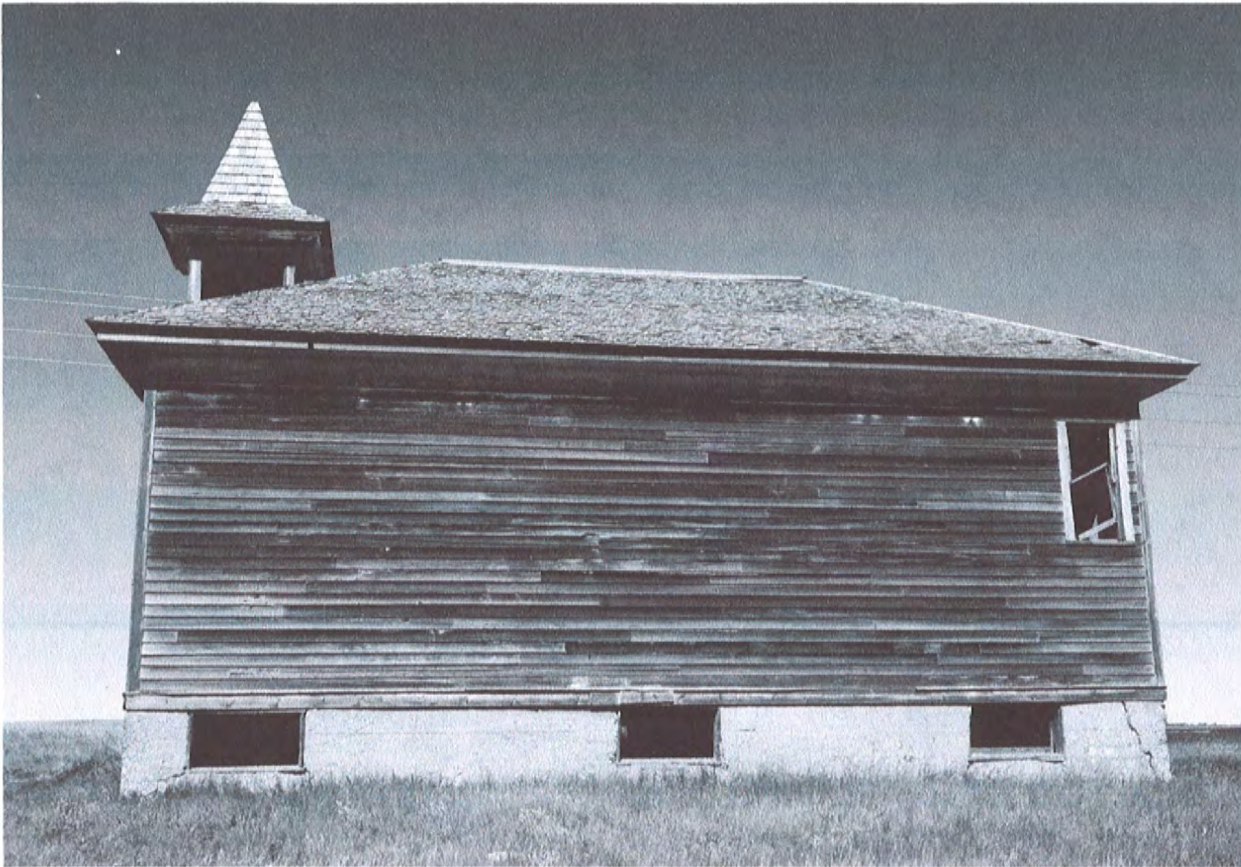
