#### 1. Feature Description, Integrity, Eligibility:

The feature is a one room prairie school on a poured concrete basement. The intersecting gable roofs and the entry roof are covered with asphalt shingles. There are cornice returns on all side of the school. At the peak of the school roof over the entry door there is a flagpole. There is also a small, square window with glass. There is a red brick stub of a chimney. Bathroom vent pipes are on the west slope of the forward gable. The builging measures 28 feet by 28 feet with the entry measuring 6 feet by 8 feet.

There is a wide trim board under the soffits on all the peak ends of the school. The remainder of the siding is 6 inch wood lap with metal corner caps. The entry porch, reached by wooden steps with wooden rail, has a broken door, plywood has been attached on the outside. There is one double hung, three over one, window on the east side of the entry porch. The west wall has two large boarded in areas and one smaller one that were likely windows. On the north wall it looks like they completely removed a bank of windows and completely resided this wall with the addition of two casement windows. It looks like more window openings may have been sided over on the south side as well. The porch leads into the entry which lathe and plaster walls and beadboard ceiling, there is a library to the right and bathrooms to the left, located in this part of the building. There are several wood doors in fairly good shape. The interior walls of the main room of the school are covered with panel. The floor is hardwood covered with tile. The ceiling is covere with pressed tin. Blackboards are on the east wall and the south wall to the left of the entry door as you walk into the room. Wiring and light fixtures suggest electricity.
