The feature is a onr room prairies school on a foundation of roaks, mortar and concrete. The intersecting gable roofs are covered with particle board while the entry roof is covered with ribbed metal sheeting. Perhaps the remainder of the roof would be coverd with metal sheeting as well. There is as red brick chimney at the west peak. There is a flagpole at the peak of the entry on the south side. The soffits are closed. the building measures 28 feet west to east and 20 feet north to south with the entry measureing 12 feet by 8 feet.

There is a wide trim board under the soffits at the peak ends of the school. The siding continues with 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch corner trim finishing with waterboard and a skirting board. Each corner of the school and entry has a piece of metal wrapped around about two feet off the ground to keep varmints out. The entry has one double hung window on the south wall, some glass. Under the peak of the entry on the south side as well as the east side are two circular window openings. The entry has a port to the east with a support post on the southeast corner. A concrete slabe leads to the 5 panel wood door. The entry walls are coverd with beadboard. There is are two sets of two double hung windows on the north wall and two more sents of windows on the west wall, all covered and without glass. There is one more covered opening on the west wall that might have been a fuel door. The interior walls and ceiling are covered with wallboard. A blackboard is on the east wall. The floor is tongue and groove pine. No evidence of electricity.

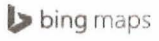

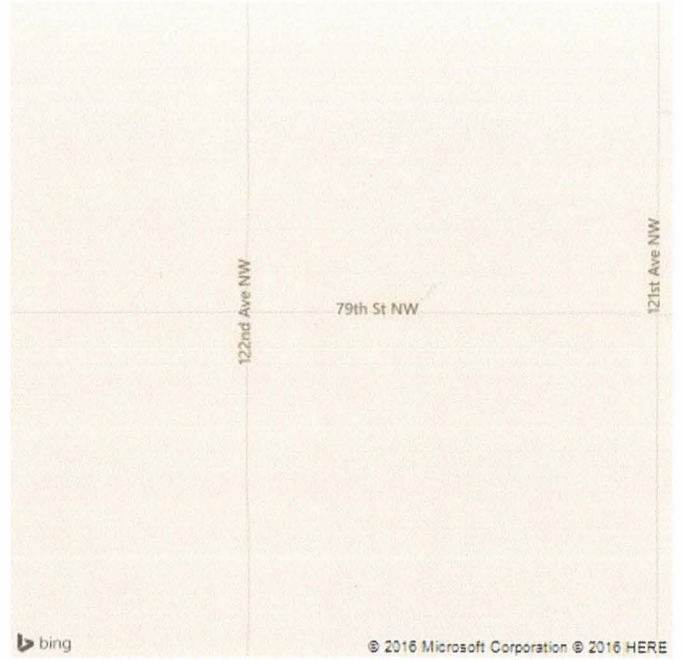
