The feature is a one room school on a poured concrete basement. The hip roof of the school and half hip of the entry are covered with wood shakes with metal capping and finials. There is a large orange brick chimney on the south slope of the entry. The soffits are closed with beadboard. There are attic vents near the top of the north and south slopes of the school room. The building measures 24 feet north to south and 16 feet east to west with the entry measuring 12 feet north to south by 8 feet east to west.

There is a wide trim board under the soffits on all sides. The remainder of the siding is 4 inch wood lap with 4 inch wood corner trim down to a waterboard and skirting board. The basement is crumbling away on the northeast corner. There are two small boarded up windows on the north and south basement walls, one two pane window on the west side. There is one boarded up window on the east wall of the entry. A porch roof over the stoop is supported at the southeast corner by a post. There are no steps approaching the failing wood stoop to reach the broken entry door. Two sets of three double hung windows on the west wall have some framing, no glass, and all but one are covered. The interior walls are a combination of lathe and plaster wallboard with a wide trim board at the floor level. Blackboards are on parts of the south and east walls and all of the north wall. The floor is tongue and groove hardwood. Wiring and a meter box on the east wide of the entry wall suggest electricity.

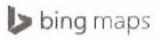

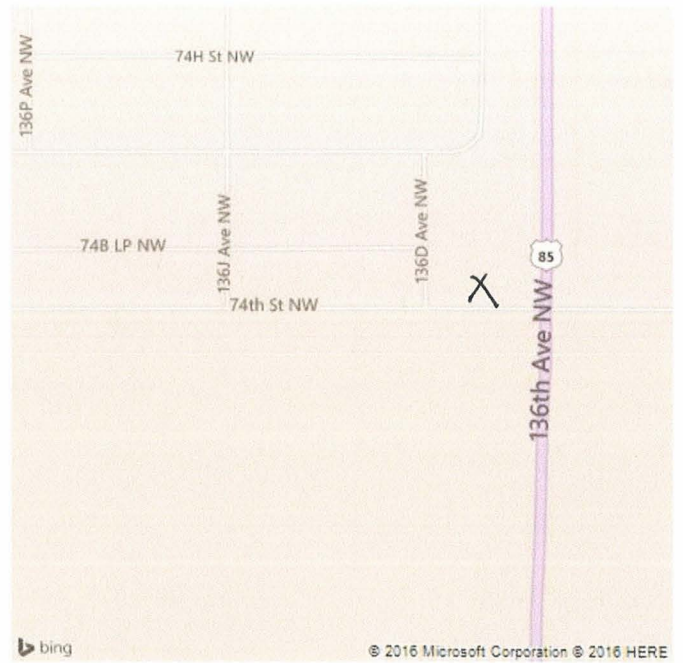
