The feature is a one room prairie school on a poured concrete basement. The intersecting gable roofs, the hip roof on the addition and pyramidal roof of the bell tower are all covered with wood shakes with metal capping and finials. There are cornice returns on all the gable ends. There is a large red brick chimney on the east slope of the roof at the north end. The bell tower has a base of wood with the sides covered in wood shakes and four posts supporting the roof of the tower. There are attic vents at either end, under the peak, of the main body of the school. The building measures 24 feet north to south and 20 feet east to west with the north addition measuring 12 feet by 6 feet and the entry measuring 12 feet by 12 feet, not including the porch roof and steps.

There is a wide trim board under the soffits at the peak ends of the school. The siding is 6 inch wood lap with 6 inch corner trim to a waterboard and skirting board. There are 4 pane windows in the basement, two on the east side, one on the north and two on the south. One covered opening on the west side of the basement wall. Approaching the entry are 8 steps to a cracking concrete stoop. The entry door is plywood and unlocked. The entry/coatroom walls are covered with wallboard. A 5 panel wood door gives entry into the school room. The walls and ceiling in the main room are covered with wallboard with a wide trim board at the floor. The wood floor is covered with tile. On the north wall of the school room there is a built in cupboard at the east end of the wall and two doors lead into the north addition toilets. Each of those small rooms has a small double hung window with glass intact. There are two glass block windows in the entry, one on the west wall and another on the north wall. The school room has two large vented glass windows on the east wall, likey replacements, with several venetian blinds in disrepair. There is a blackboard on the south wall and another on the west wall from the south corner to the school room door. Light fixtures suggest electricity.

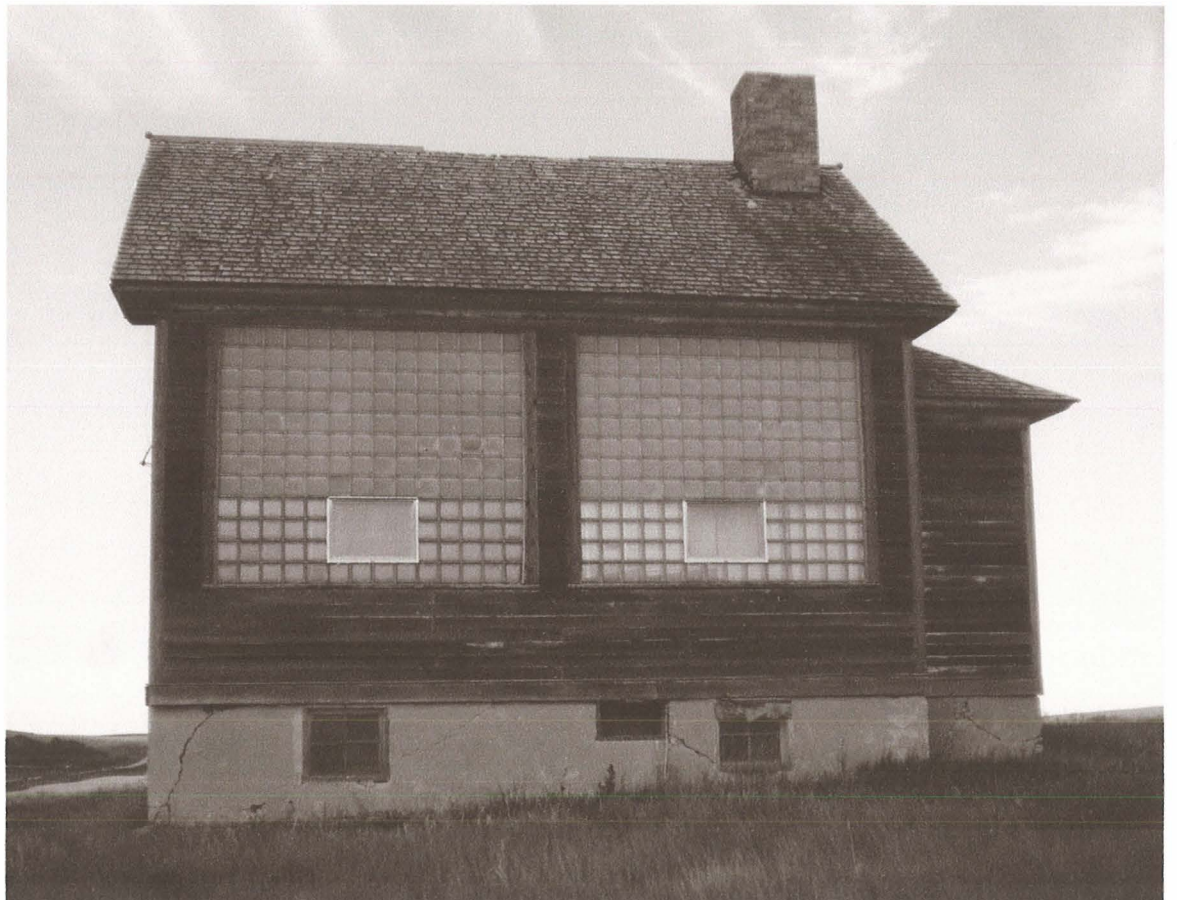

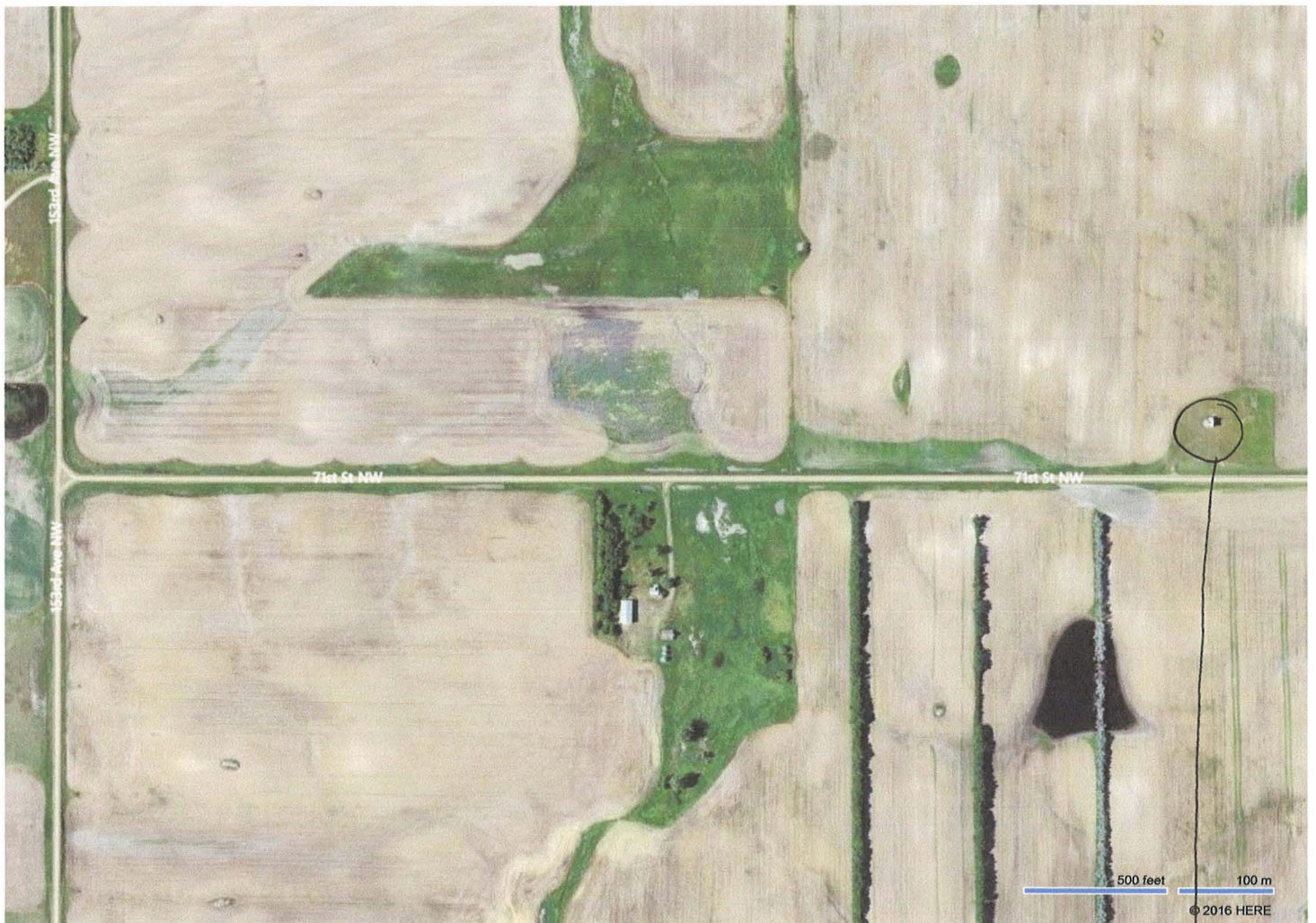
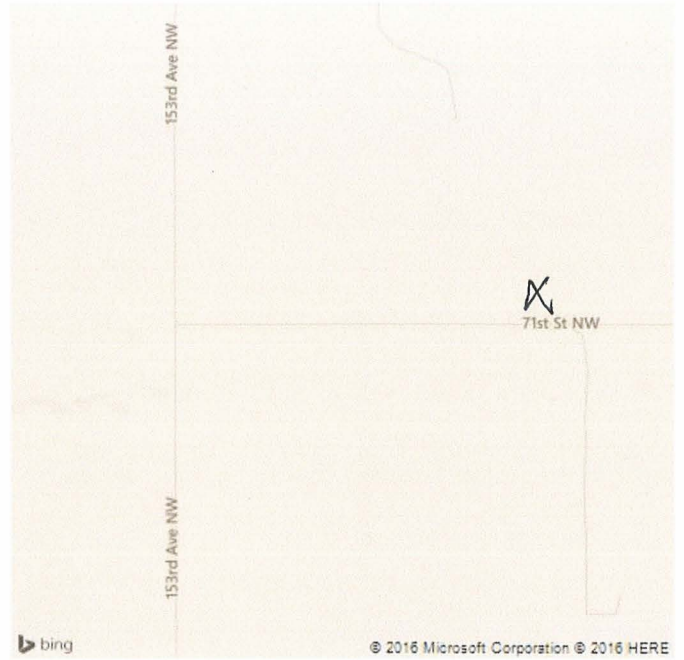
